OUR COLLEGE

Rajapalayam Rajus' College was established on 22nd June 1973 and is entering into the 50th year of service in the field of higher education in this cotton based industrial town of Rajapalayam. The 52 acre campus is situated at the foothills of the Western Ghats on the northern side of the Mudangiar Road leading to the Ayyanar Temple. Palayapalayam Rajus Mahumai Fund created an endowment and keeps contributing towards the development of the college. The college offers 12 Under Graduate and 6 Post Graduate courses in Arts and Sciences and has Research Centres in History and Commerce.

The College was accredited with B⁺⁺ Grade by NAAC in the third cycle.

OUR LIBRARY

Dr.D.Regupathy Raja Memorial Library has over 32400 books and subscribes to 33 periodicals and 6 newspapers. It subscribes to NLIST too. (National Library and Information Services)

The library has a rich collection of 1200 resources in the Reference Section, maintains a Book Bank exclusively for marginalized students and has a section for Career Guidance. RRC Readers' Forum meets regularly. Various Competitions are conducted both for college students and school students around our town. Many online competitions were conducted during the Covid Pandemic too.

ESSENCE OF THE PROGRAMME

National Librarians' Day is observed on 12th August every year to commemorate the birth anniversary of Padmashri Dr.S.R.Ranganathan (1892-1972) who is considered as the Father of Library Science in India. Dr.Ranganathan dedicated his entire life to library profession in India leaving a rich legacy.

Today, children are enveloped with a lot of distractions and spend much of their time on computers/laptops, mobiles, social networks, television, etc. There is a dire need to draw them away towards reading since it would shape their thoughts and teach them the art of living a fulfilled life.

The School Library is a gateway to knowledge and the Librarian serves as a starting point or a road map to reading. Hence we felt it essential to orient and refresh School Librarians towards effective Librarianship.
