About the College

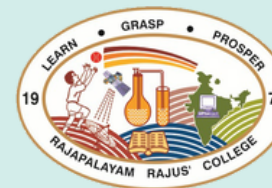

About the Department

The Department of History came into existence in 1977 offering B.A History. M.A History was introduced in 1983, followed by M.Phil History in 1989. In the year of 2006, History Department was recognized as Research Centre leading to Ph.D Degree. The Department has the credit of having successfully conducted X and XXVII Annual Sessions of South Indian History Congress in 1990 and 2007 respectively as well as XXI Annual Session of South Indian Numismatic Society in 2011. We have conducted ICHR sponsored national level seminars and published the proceedings of the same - Three day national seminar on Subaltern Freedom Fighters of Madras Presidency in 2015 and Two day national seminar on the Relevance of Gandhian Principles in Present Scenario to mark the 150th Birth Anniversary of Gandhiji in 2019. Our Department has been publishing a Biannual research journal entitled "Quest Historica- A Journal of History" since 2002. The Department has produced more than 18 Ph.D and 120 M.Phil Scholars under the able guidance of research faculty.

About the Seminar
