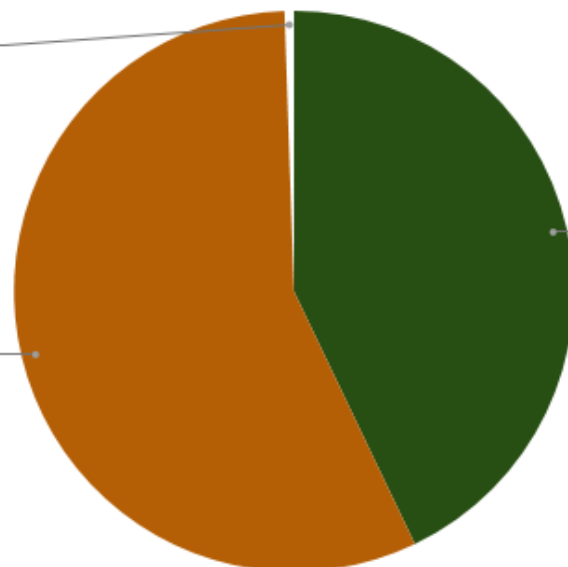

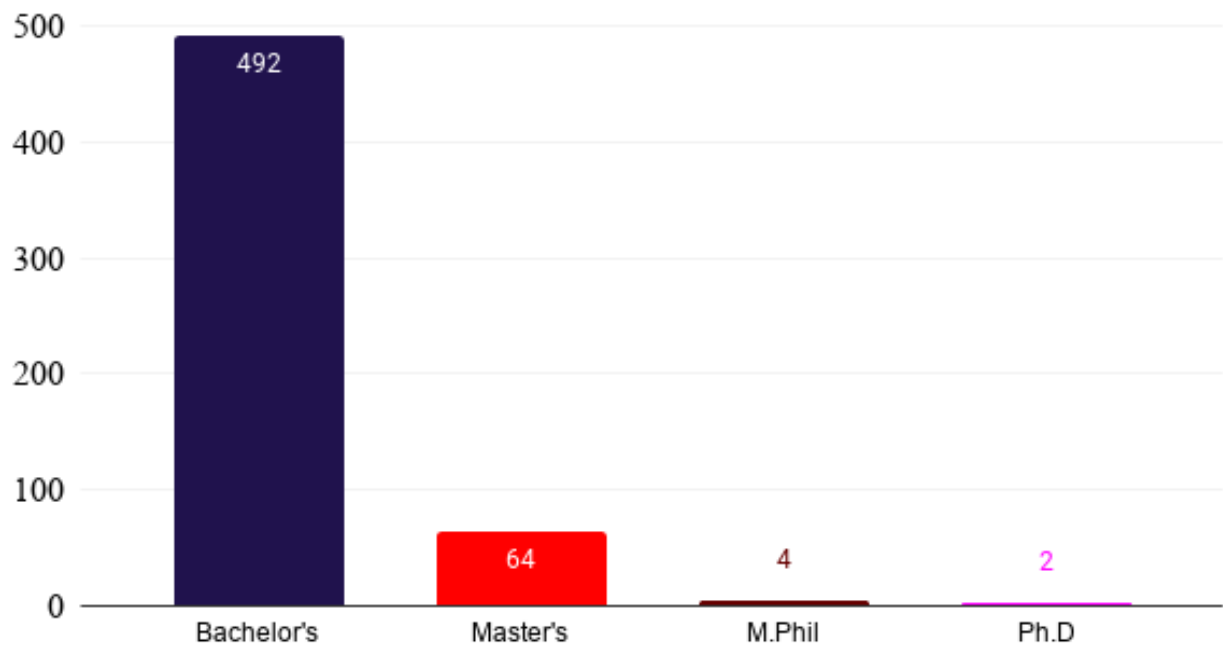

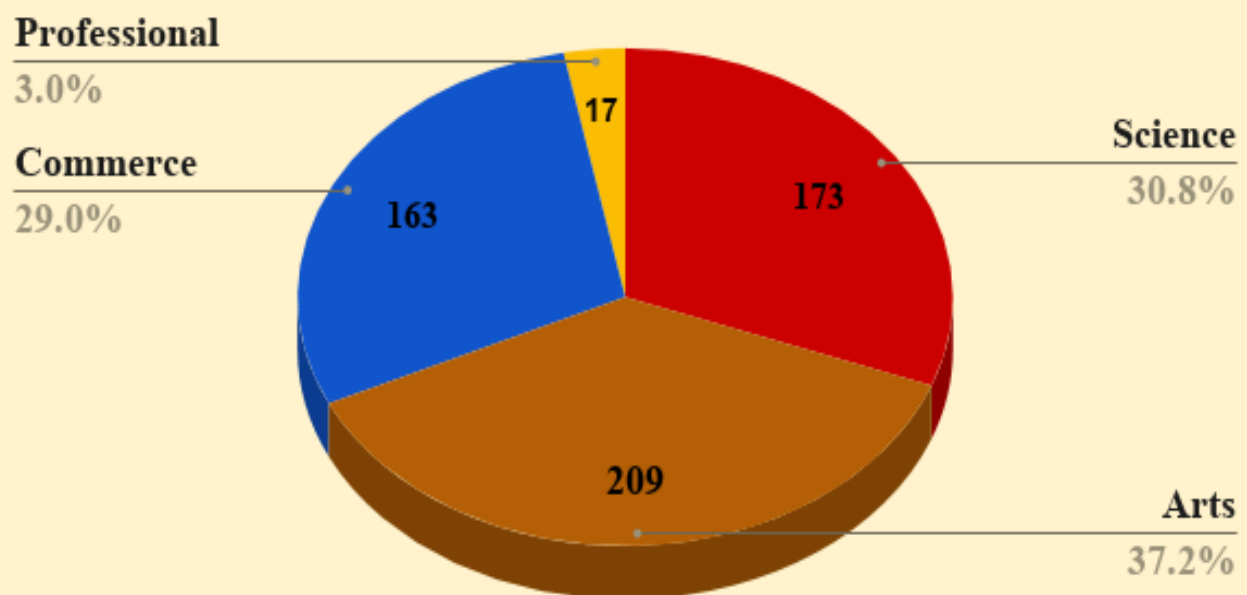

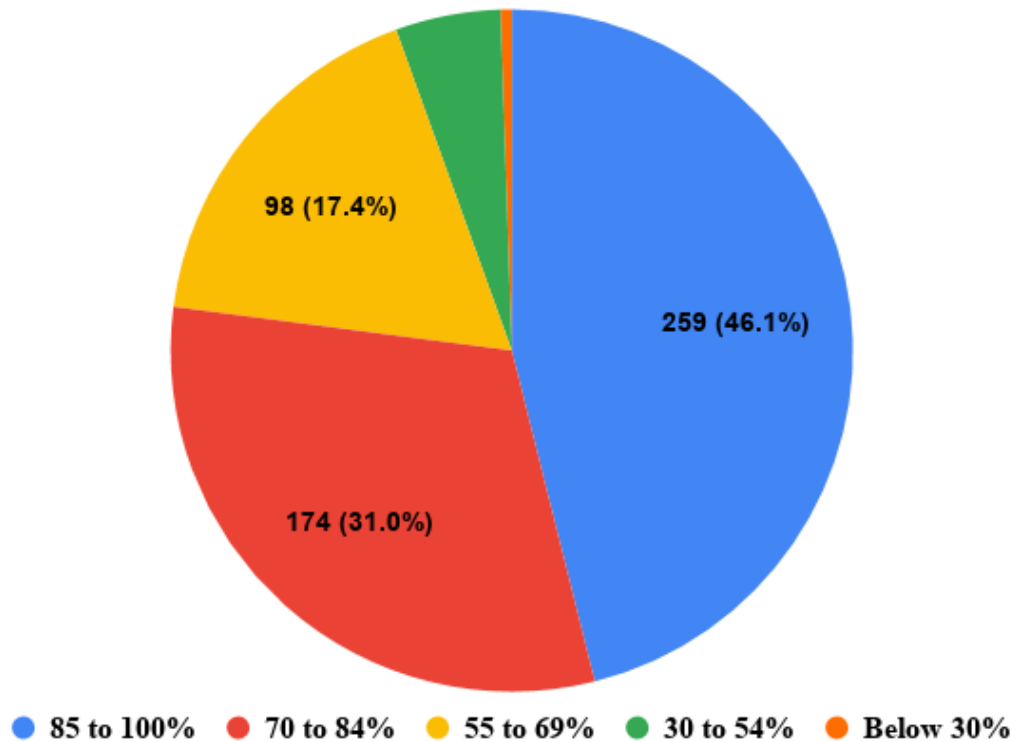
D) What degree program you are pursuing now?



E) What subject area are you currently pursuing?

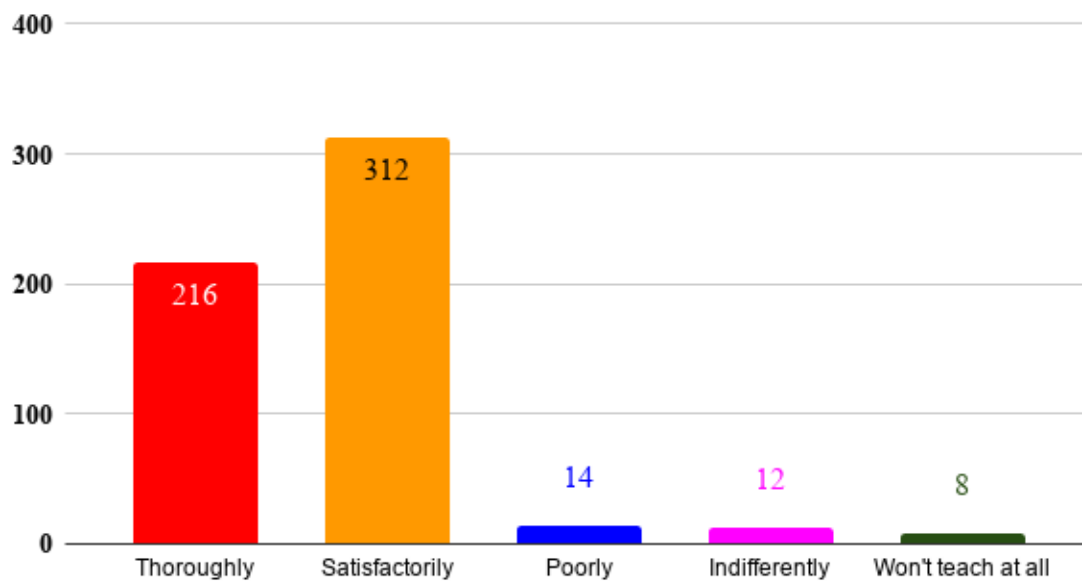


1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?



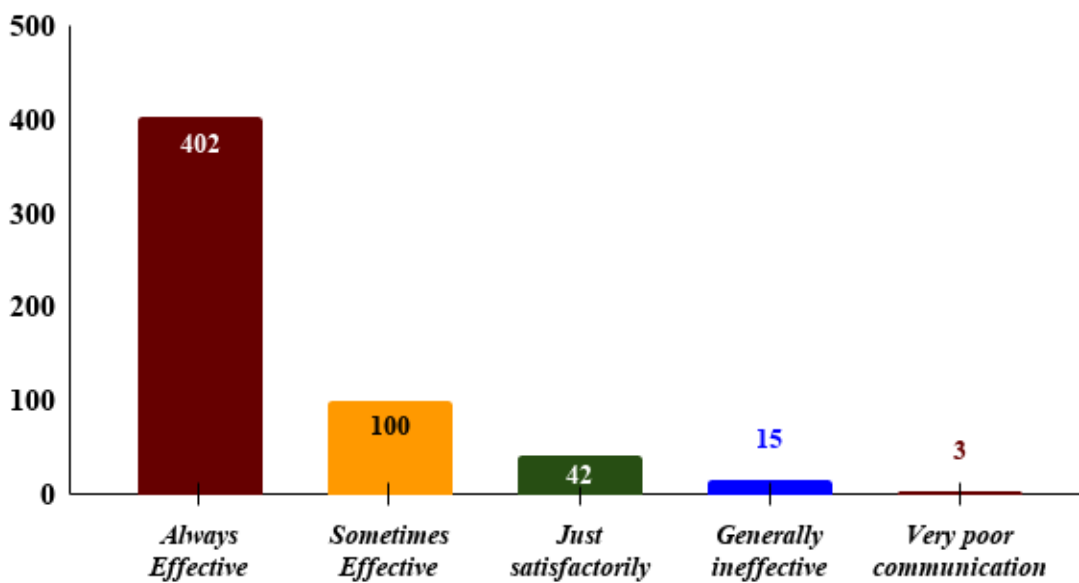
Out of 562 Students, 433 Students said 70 per cent and above syllabus were covered in the class.

2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?



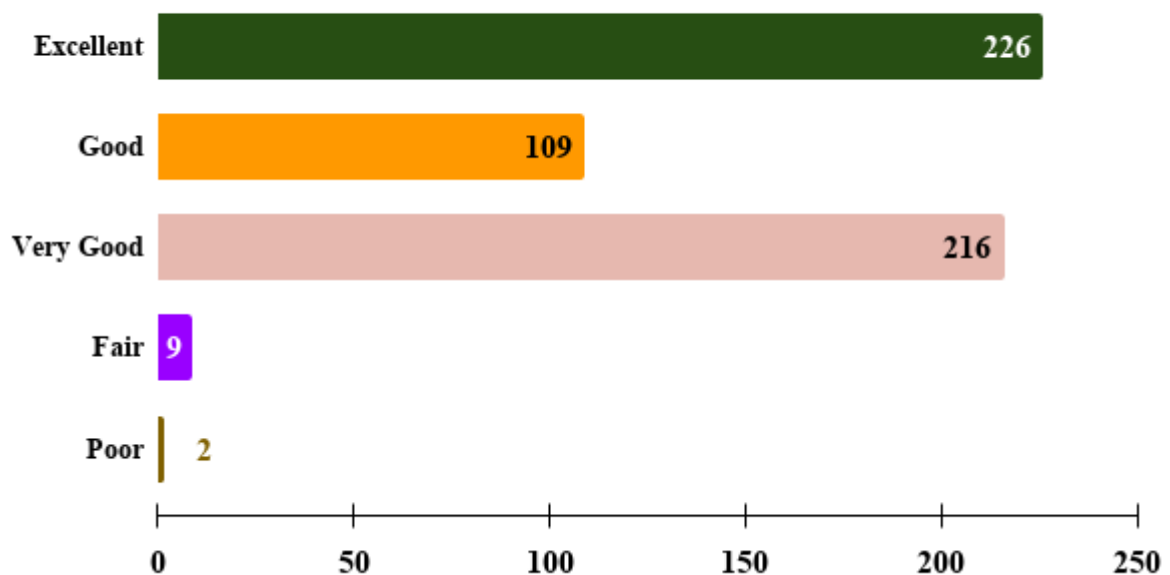
In all 94 per cent Students confirmed that teachers cover satisfactorily and above for the classes.

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?



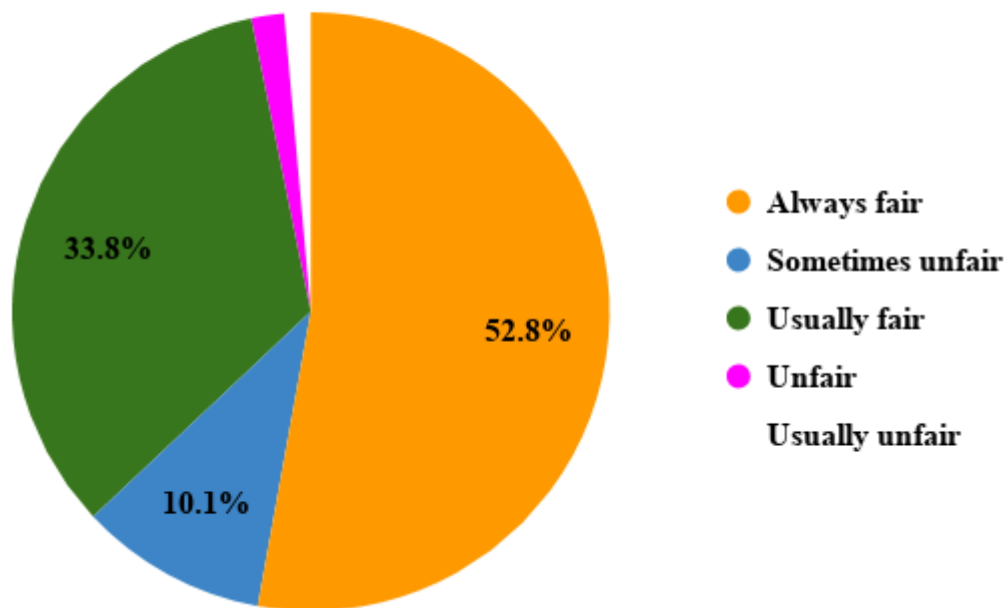
In all 89.33 per cent Students confirmed that teachers able to communicate effective and above.

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as



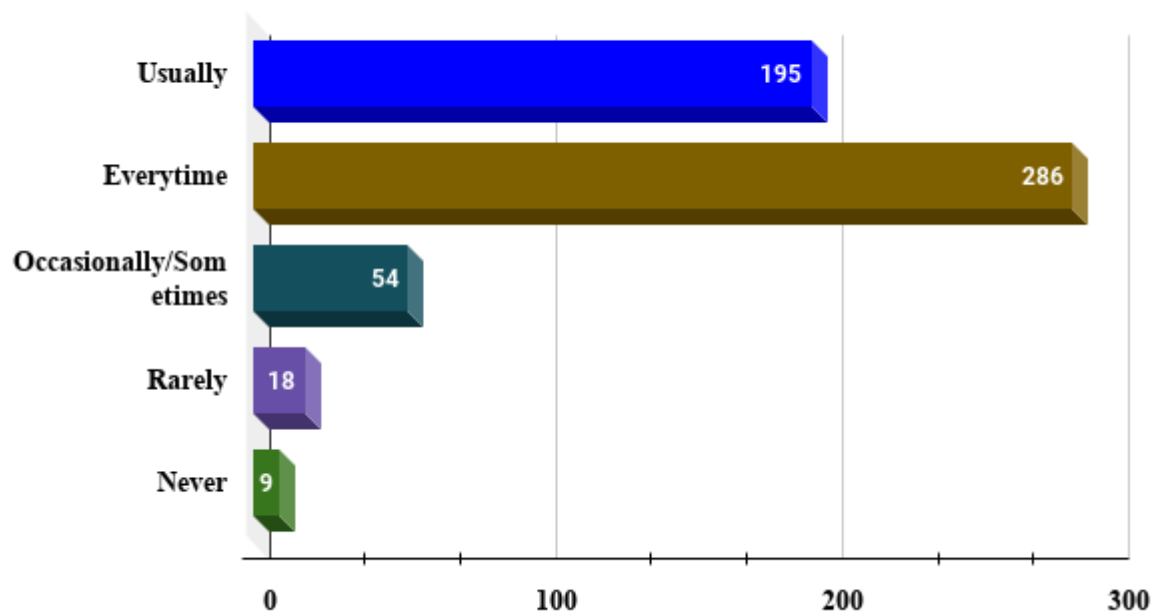
Out of 562 Students, 551 Students (98.04 per cent) confirmed that teachers approach can be described as very good and above.

5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.



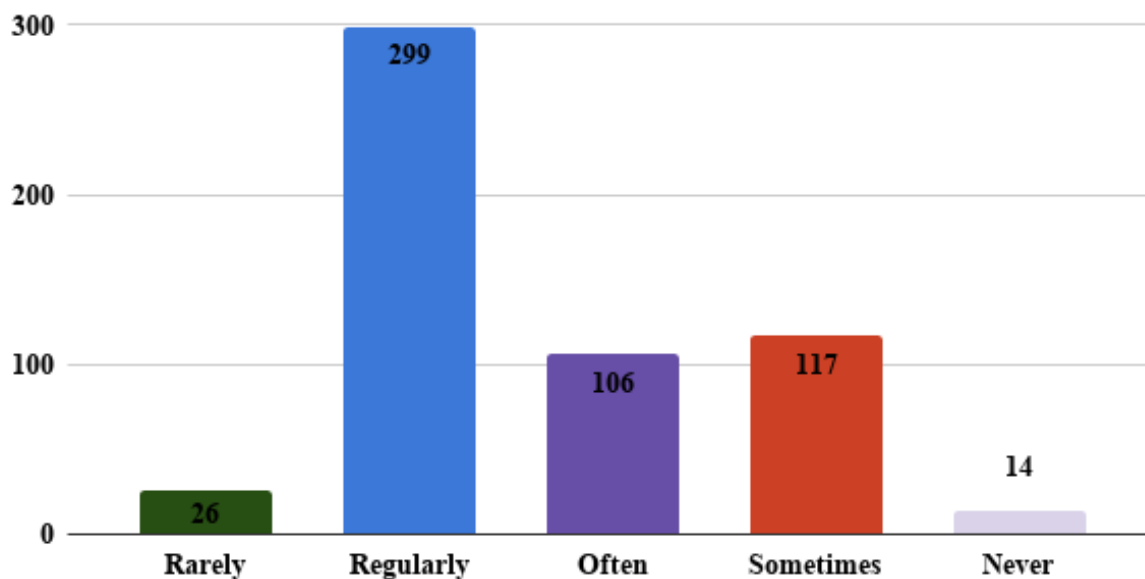
In all 86.8 per cent Students confirmed the fairness in internal evaluation process by the teachers.

6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?



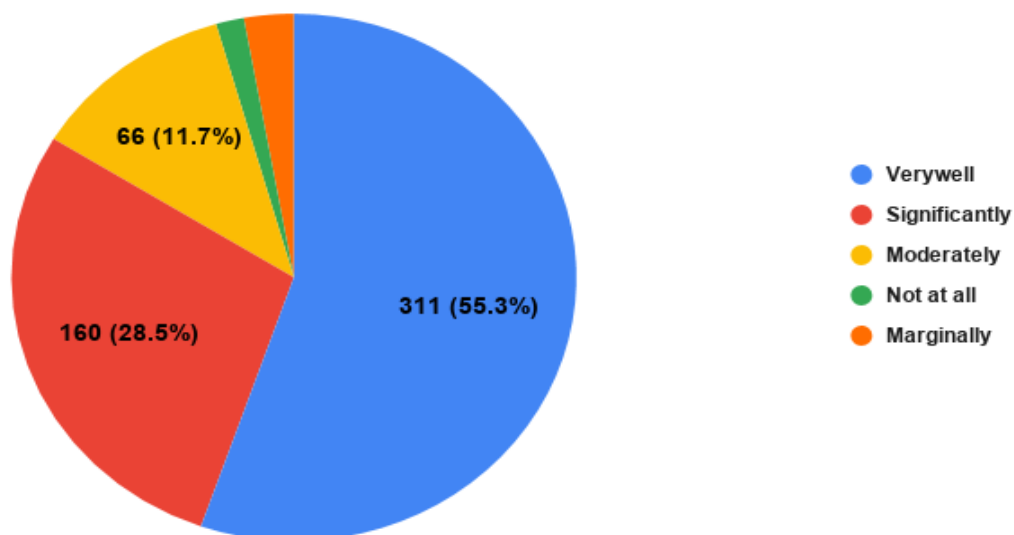
In all 481 Students (85.58 per cent) confirmed that their performance in assignments discussed with them.

7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for students.



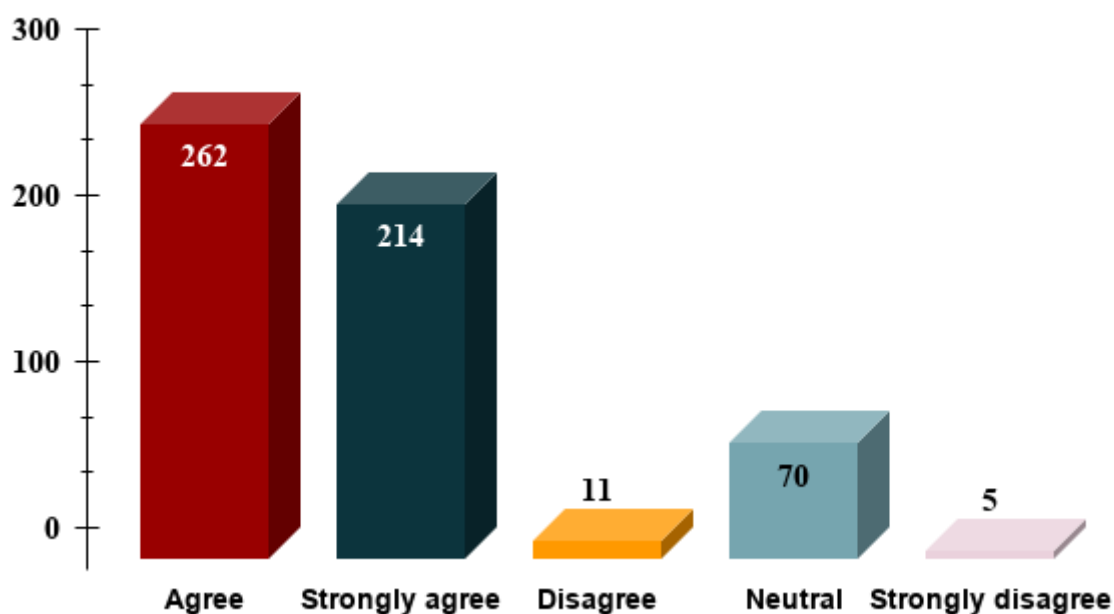

8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.



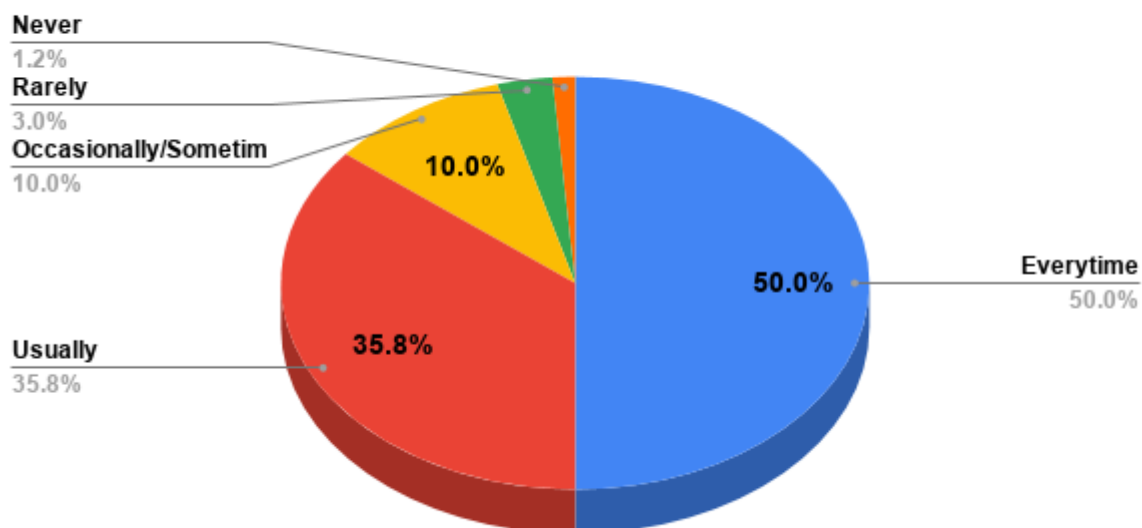
In all 537 Students (95.55 percent) confirmed that institute's teaching and mentoring process facilitates in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow



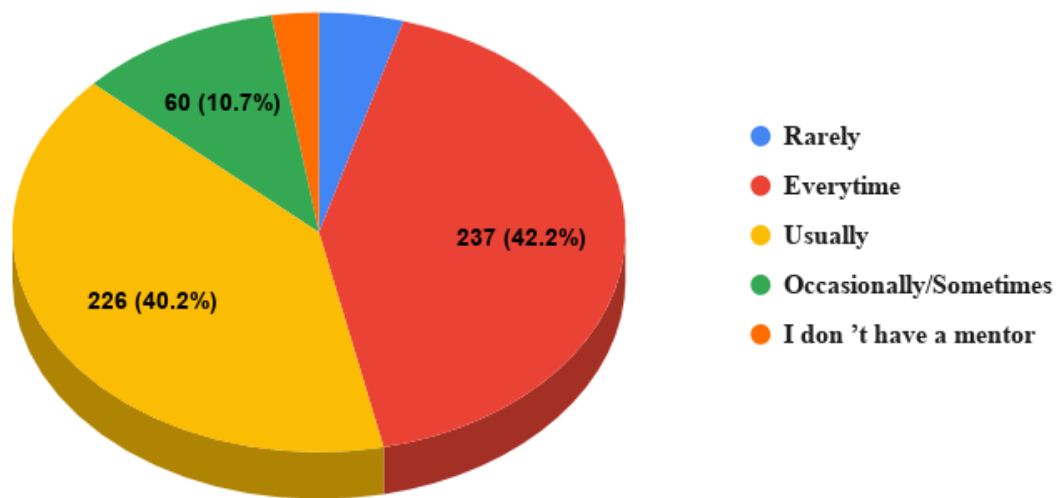
In all 474 (84.34 per cent) Students confirmed that institute provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcomes



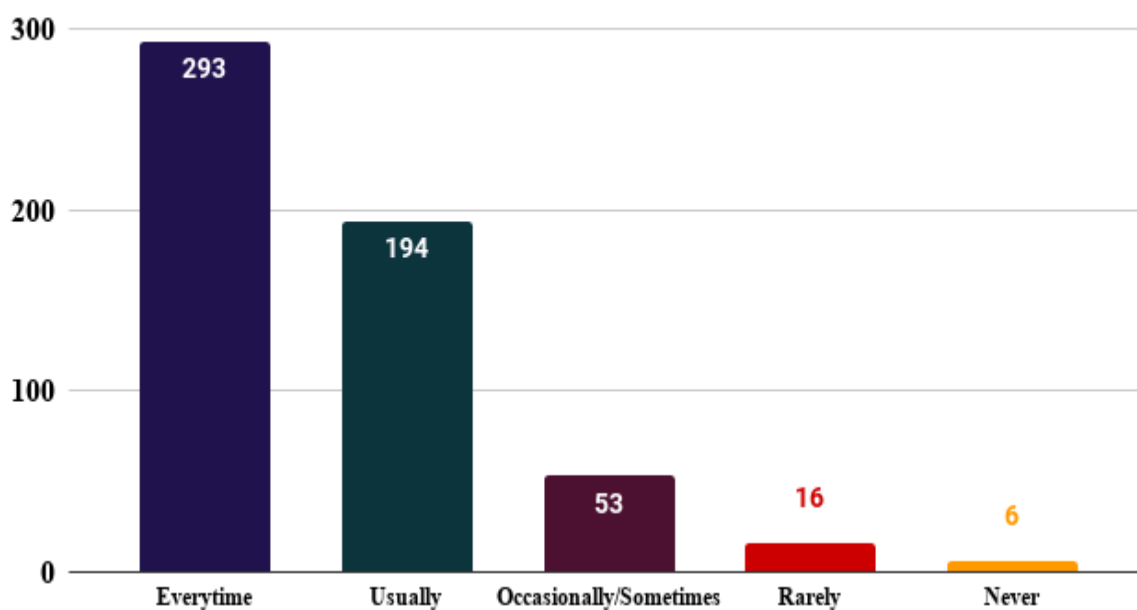

11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.



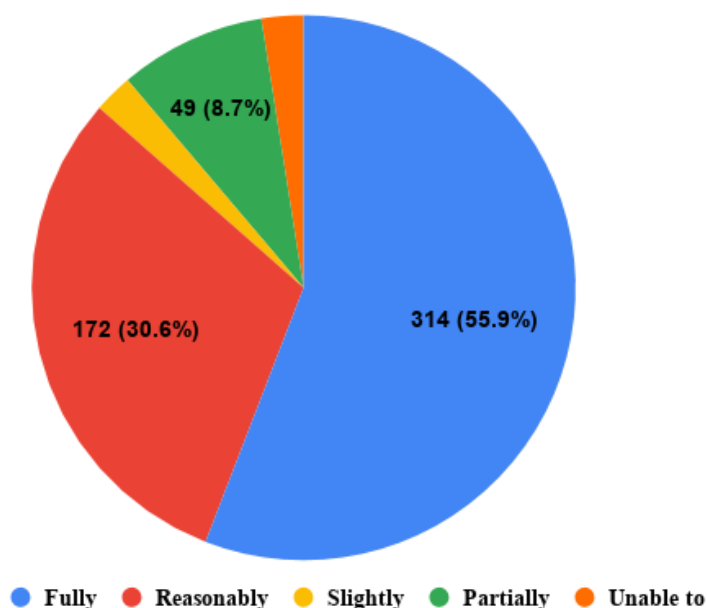
In all 463 (82.4 per cent) Students confirmed that their mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to them.

12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.



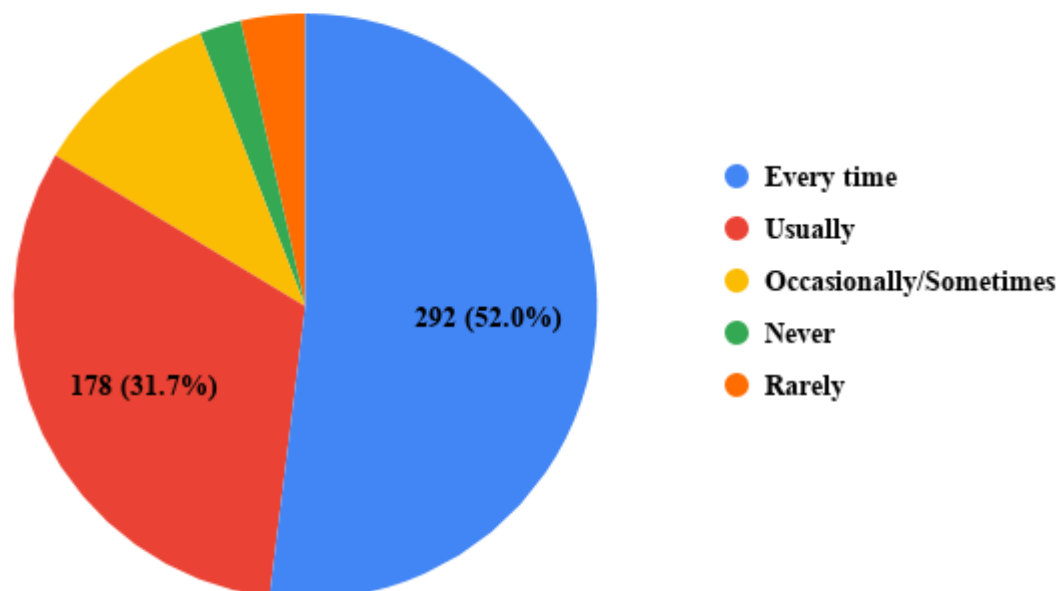
In all 487 Students (86.05 per cent) confirmed that their teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.



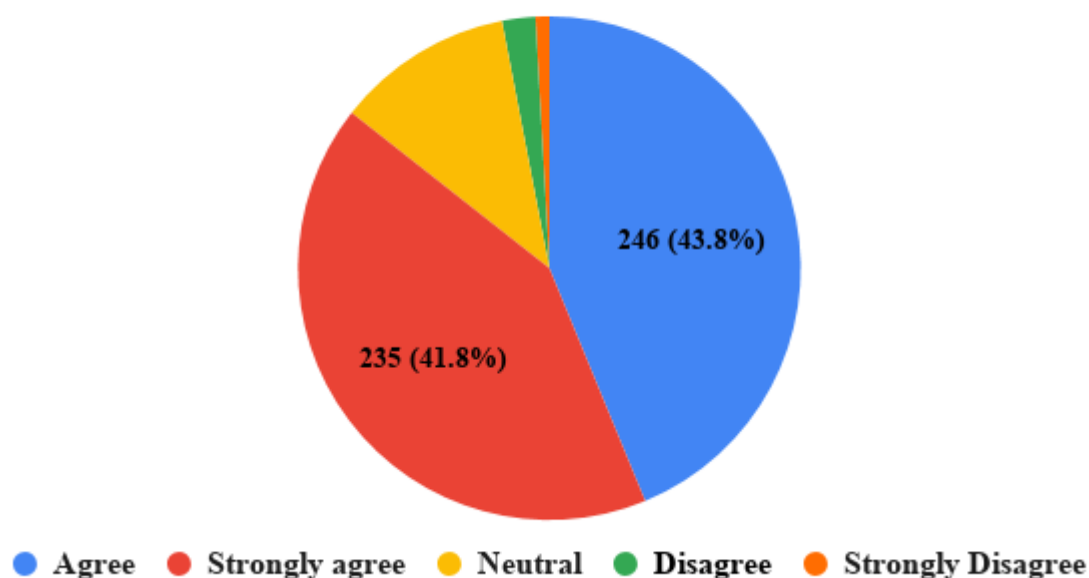
In all 486 (86.47 per cent) students confirmed that their teachers identify strengths and encourage us providing right level of challenges.

14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.



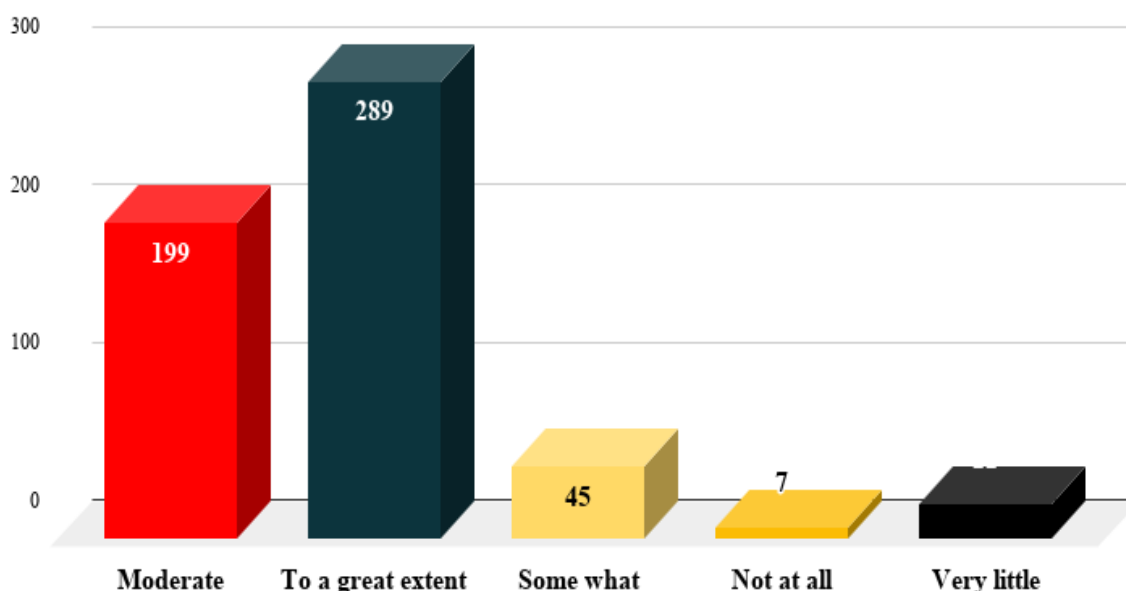
Out of 562 Students, 470 Students (83.63 per cent) confirmed that their teachers are able to identify their weaknesses and help to overcome them.

15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.



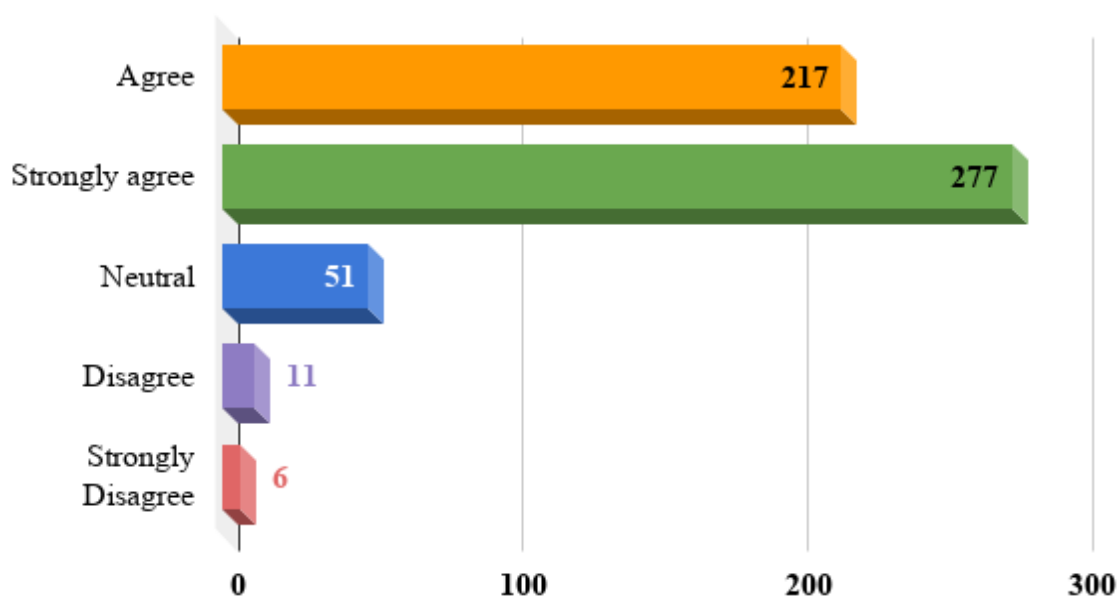

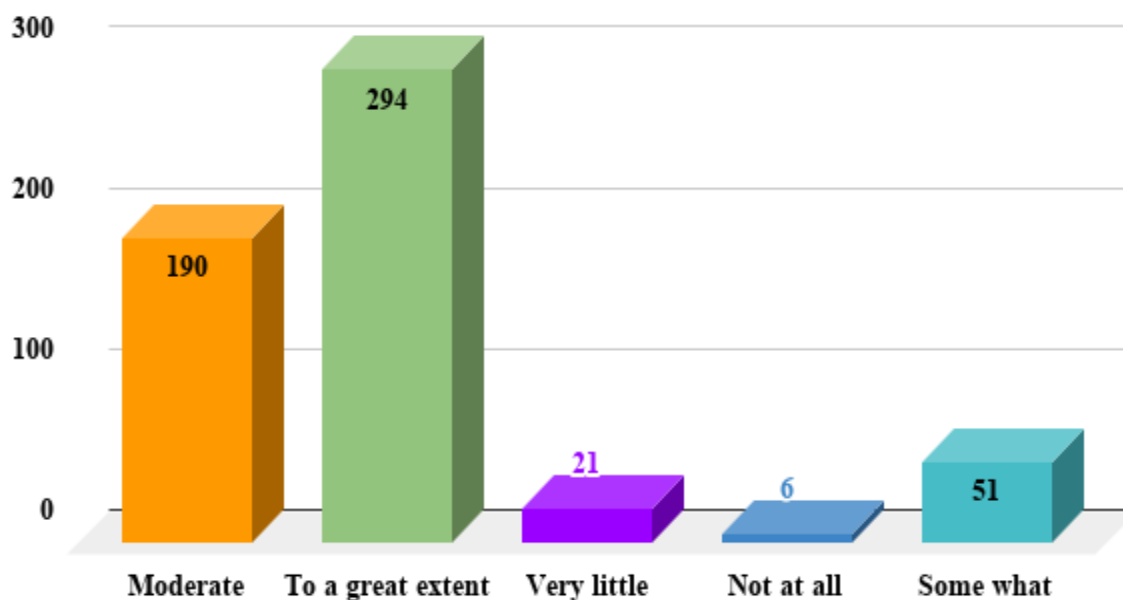

17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.



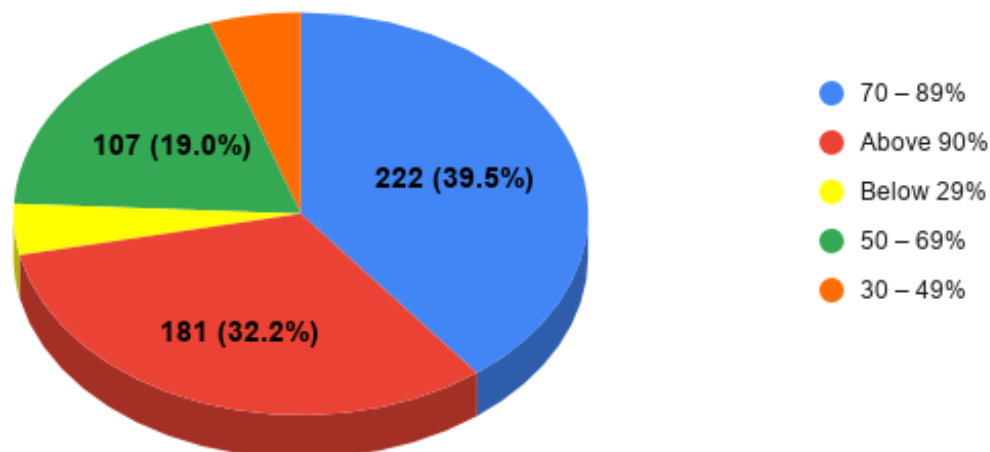
Out of 562 Students, 494 Students (87.90 per cent) confirmed that teacher's encourage us to participate in extracurricular activities.

18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.



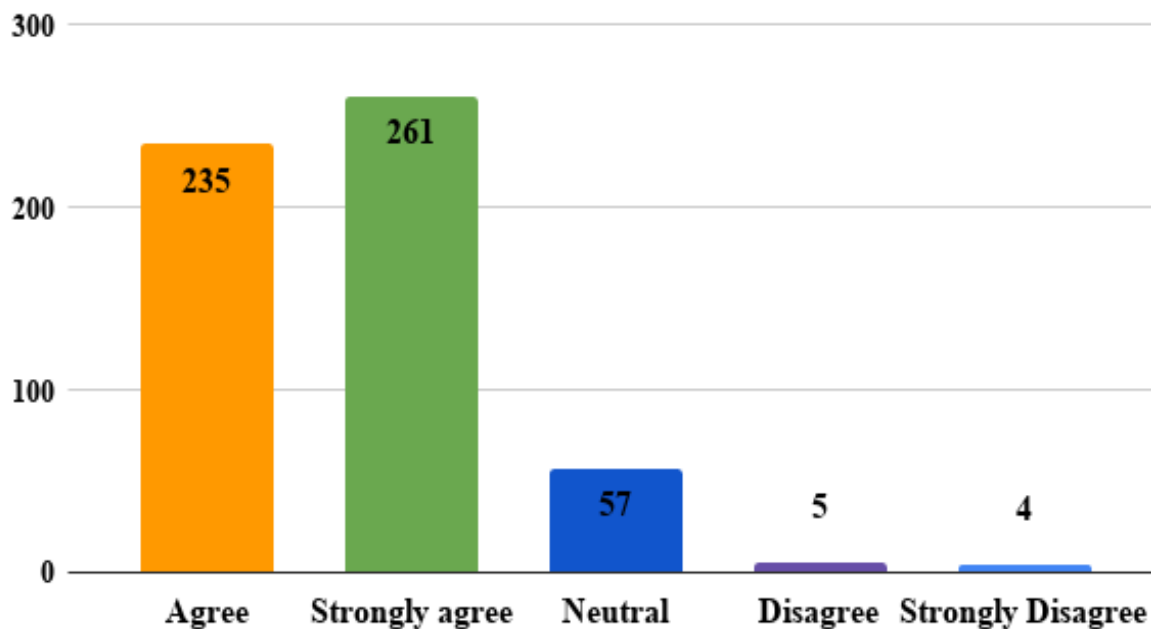

19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.



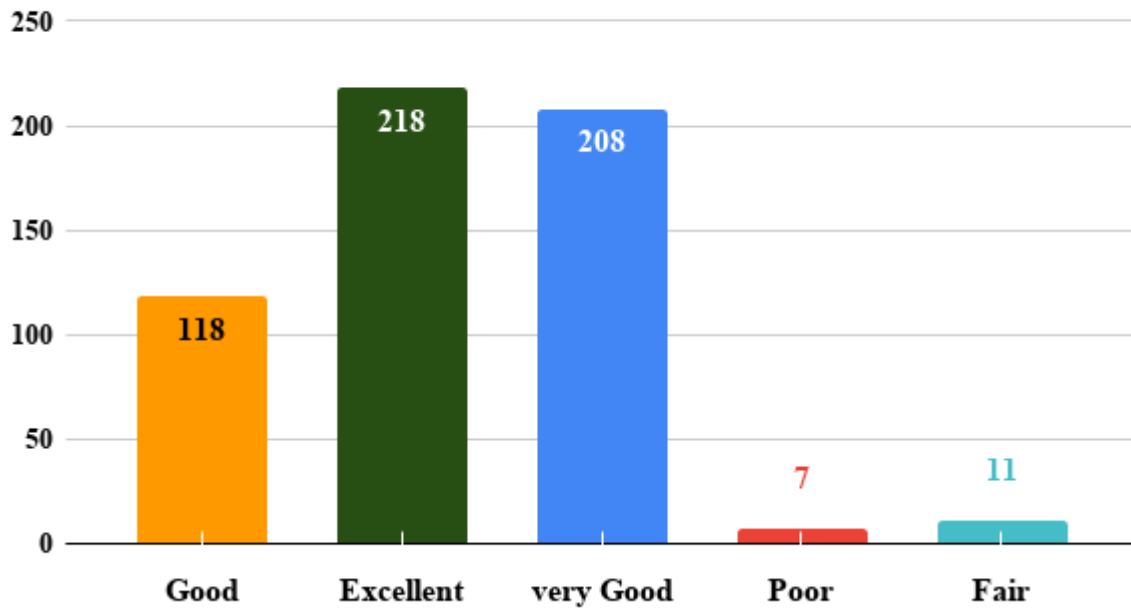
In all 403 Students (71.71 per cent) confirmed that 70 per cent and above teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, multimedia etc. While teaching.

20. The overall quality of teaching-learning process in your institute is very good.



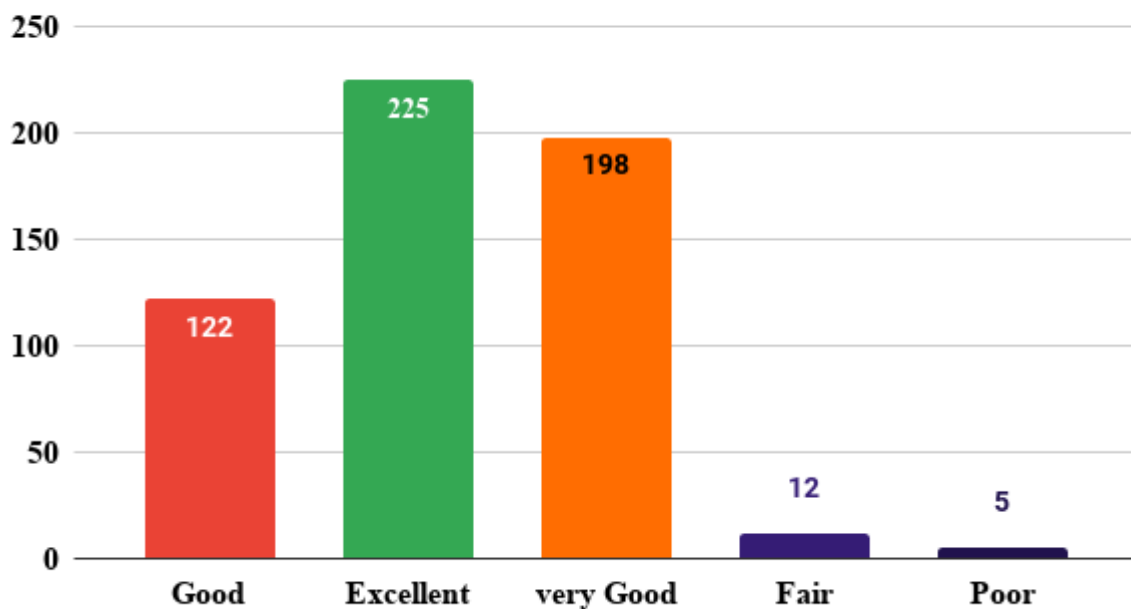
In all 491 Students (87.37 per cent) confirmed that overall quality of teaching-learning process in this institute is very good.

21. Quality of the programmes offered in the College?



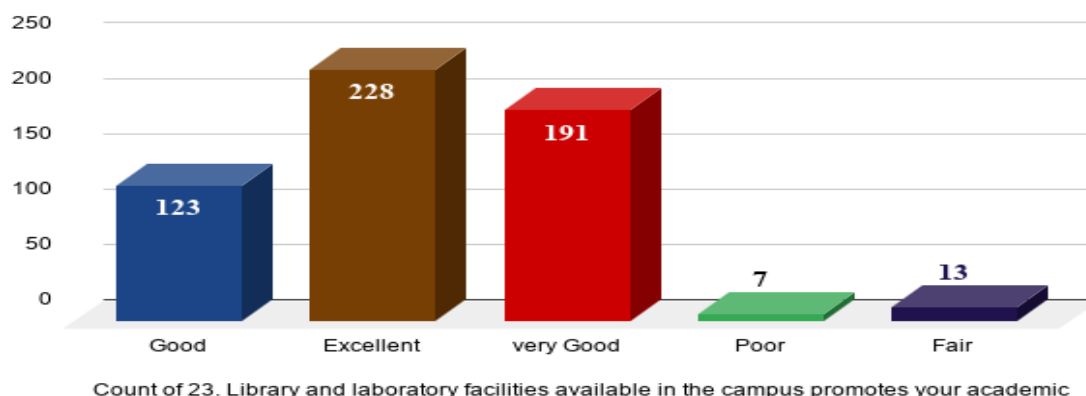
Out of 562 Students, 426 Students (75.80 per cent) confirmed that very good and above about quality of the programmes offered by the institute.

22. Faculty Support for your continuous academic growth?



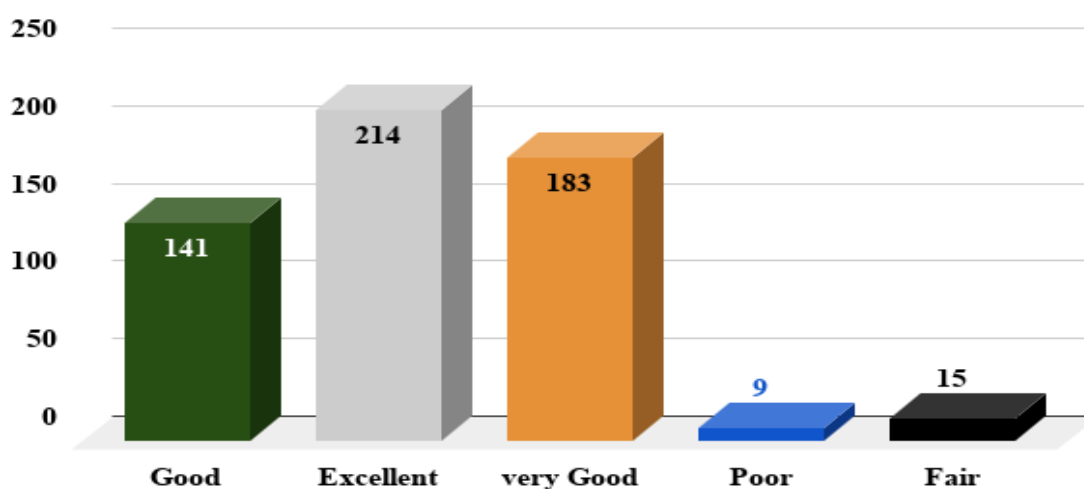
Out of 562 Students, 423 Students (75.26 per cent) confirmed that faculty support for continuous academic growth for students.

23. Library and laboratory facilities available in the campus promotes your academic pursuit



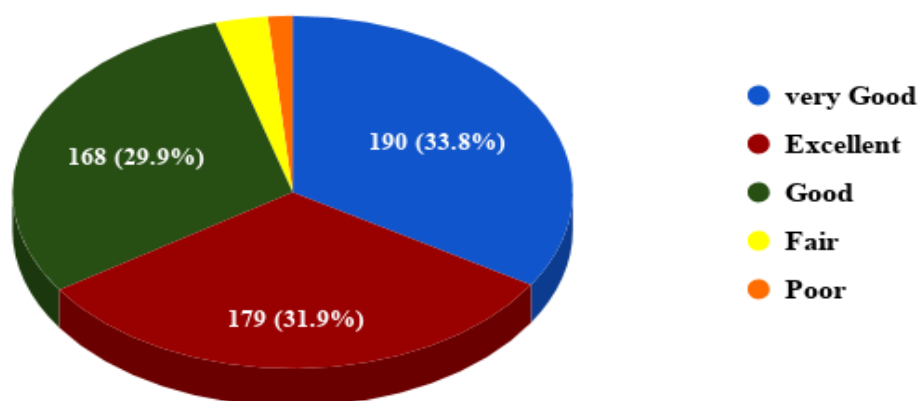
Out of 562 Students, 419 Students (74.55 per cent) confirmed that a Library and Laboratory facility available in the campus promotes academic pursuit for students.
