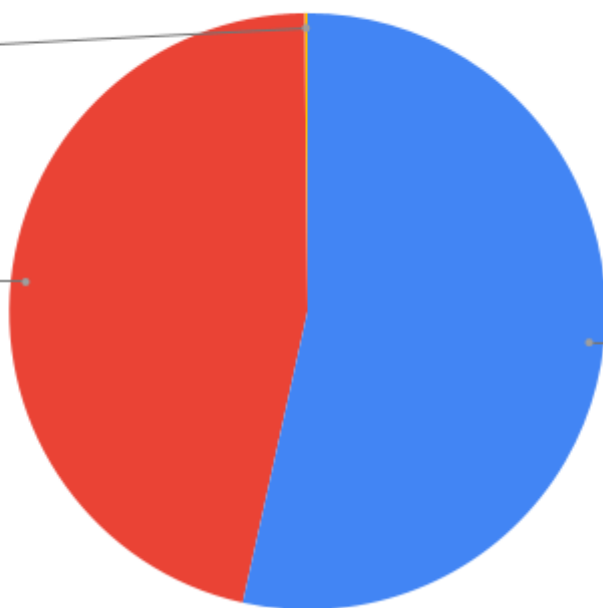

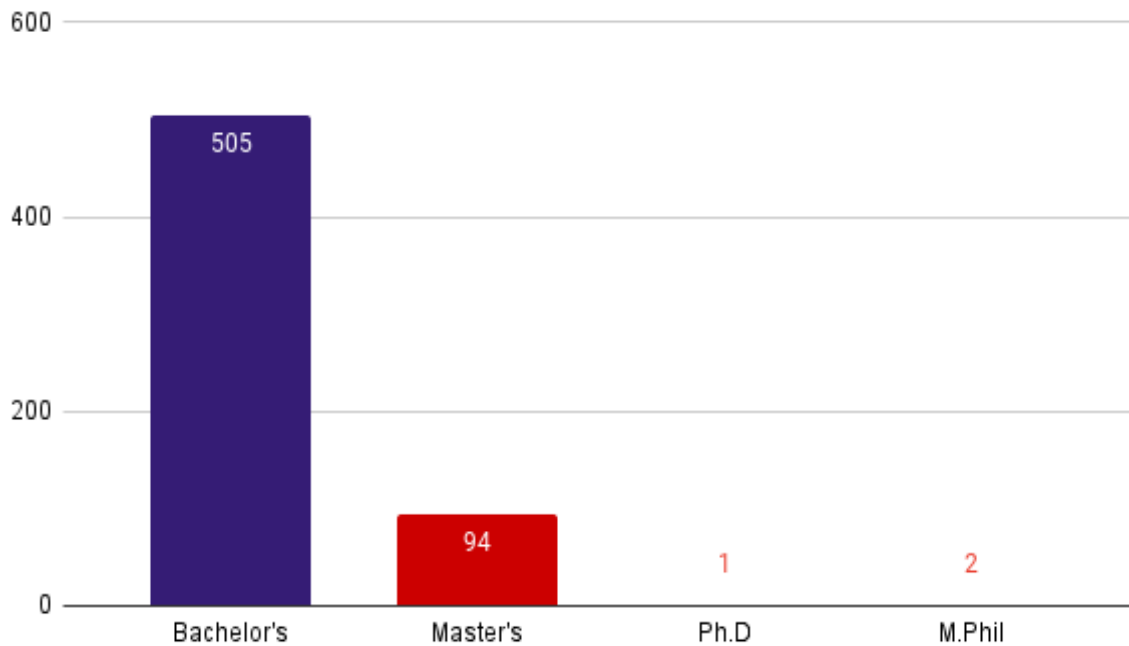

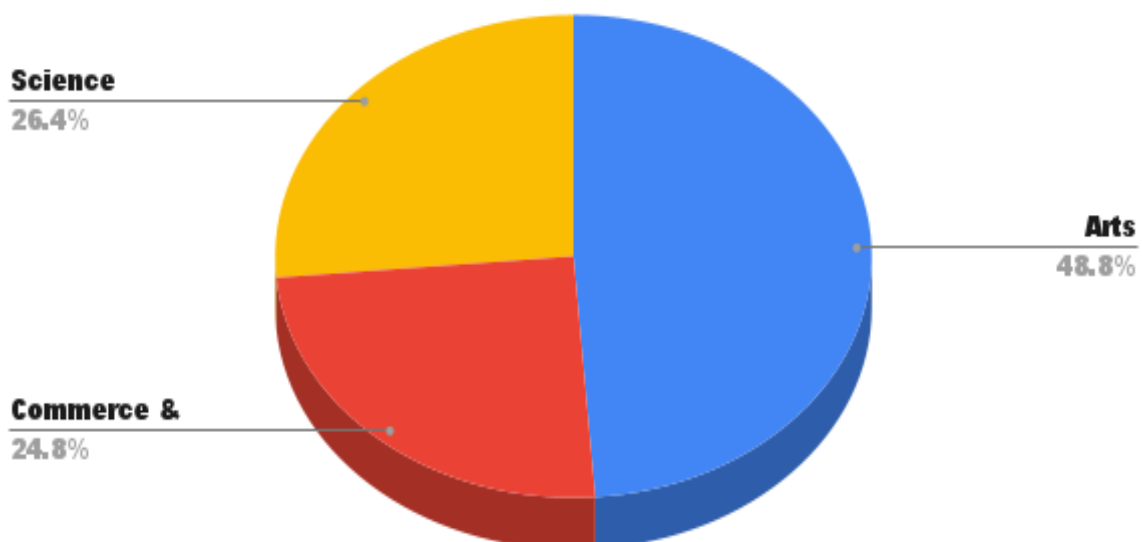

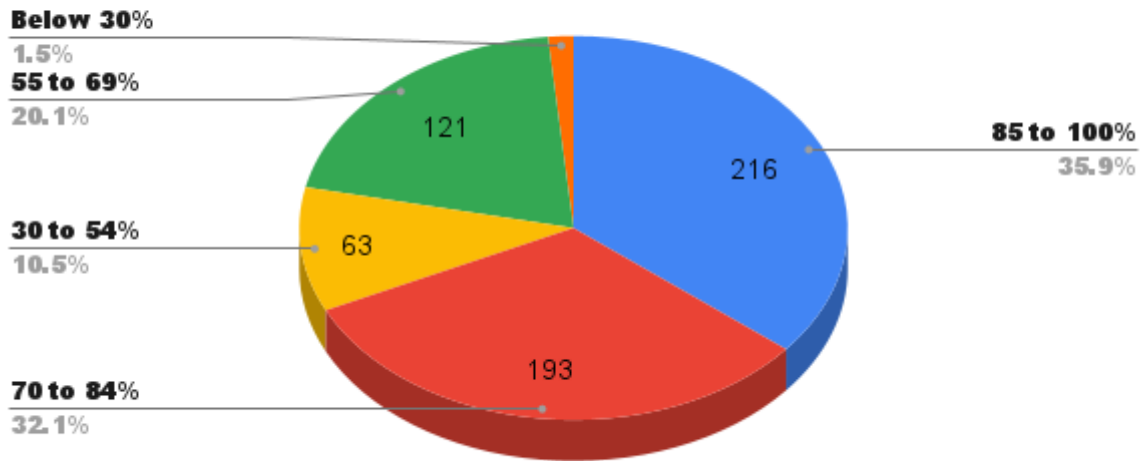
D) What degree program you are pursuing now?



E) What subject area are you currently pursuing?

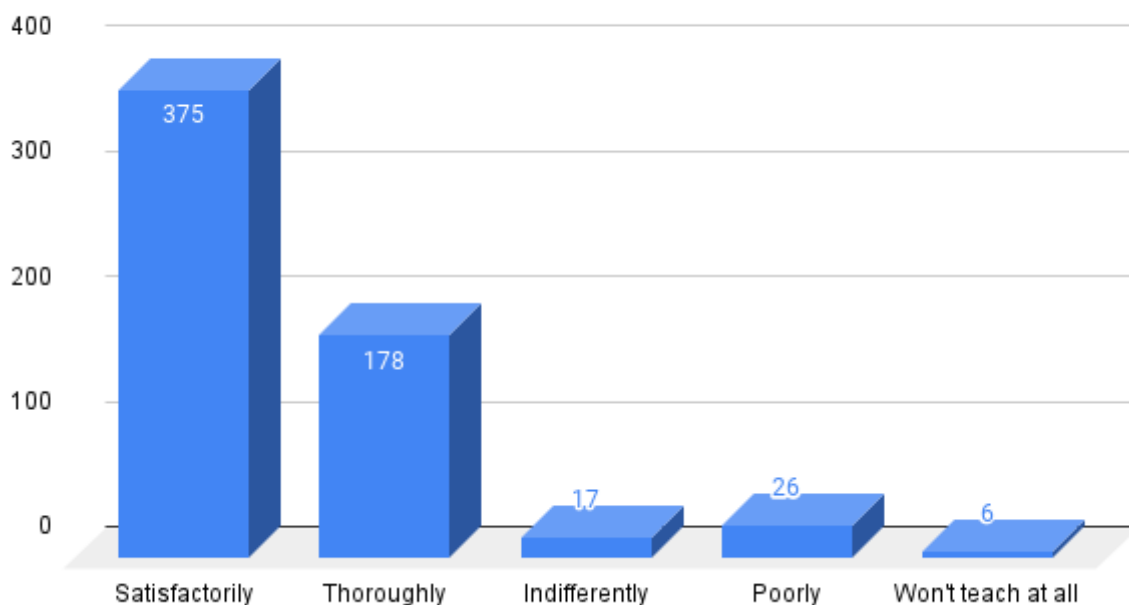


1. How much of the syllabus was covered in the class?



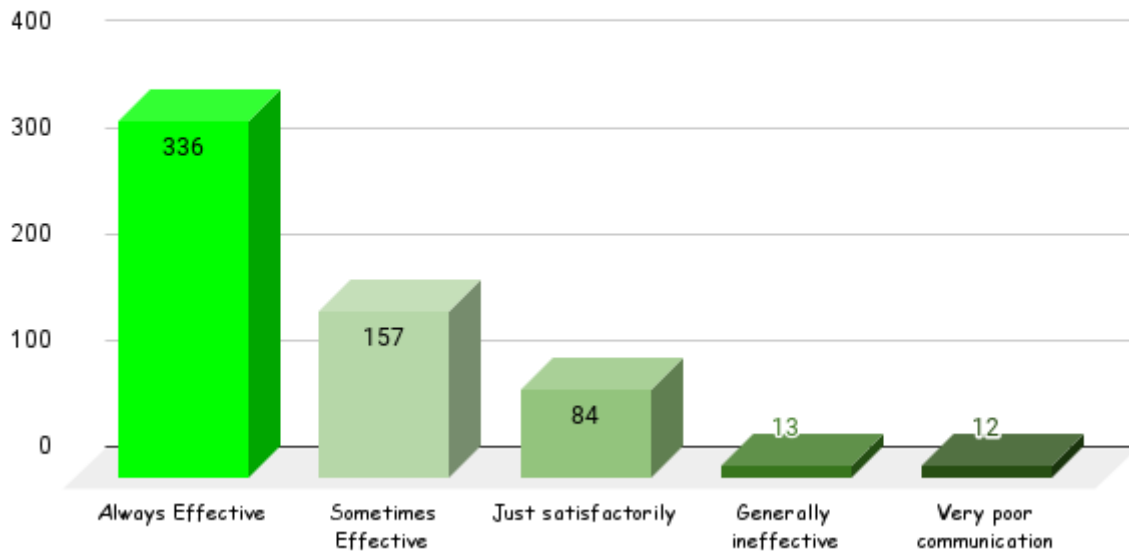
Out of 602 Students, 409 Students said 70 per cent and above syllabus were covered in the class.

2. How well did the teachers prepare for the classes?



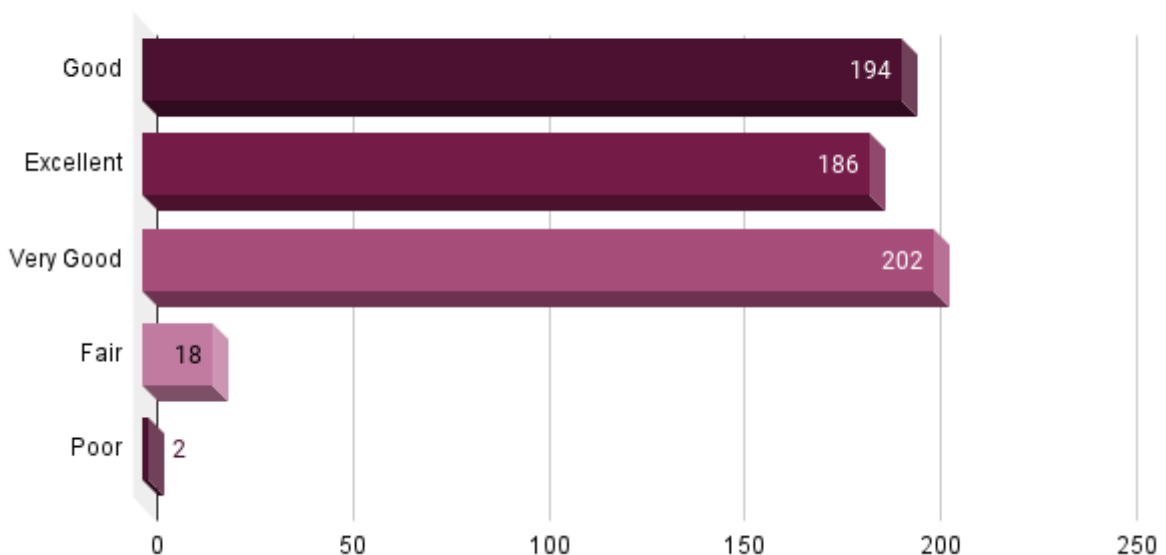
In all 91.96 per cent Students confirmed that teachers cover Thoroughly and satisfactorily for the classes.

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?



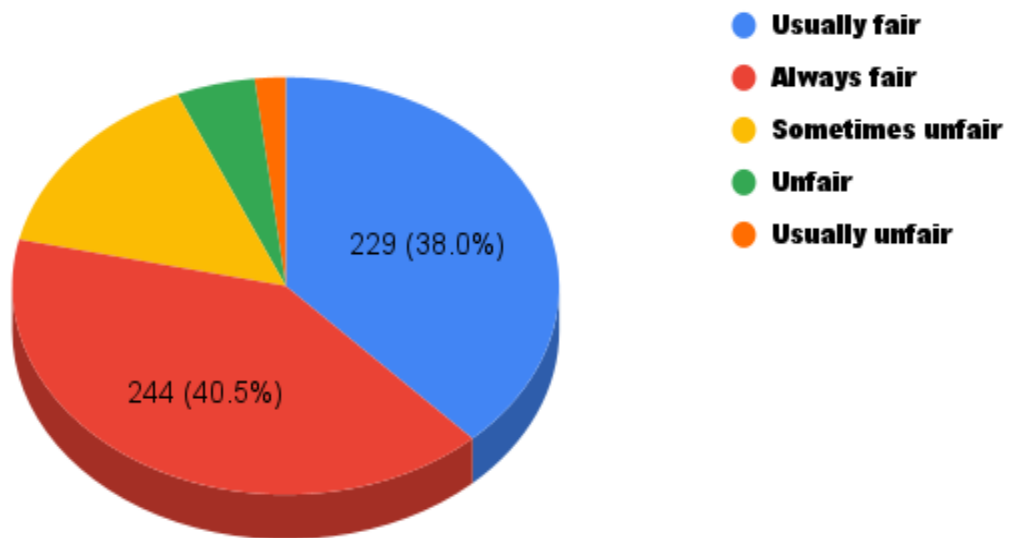
In all 81.89 per cent Students confirmed that teachers able to communicate effective and above.

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can best be described as



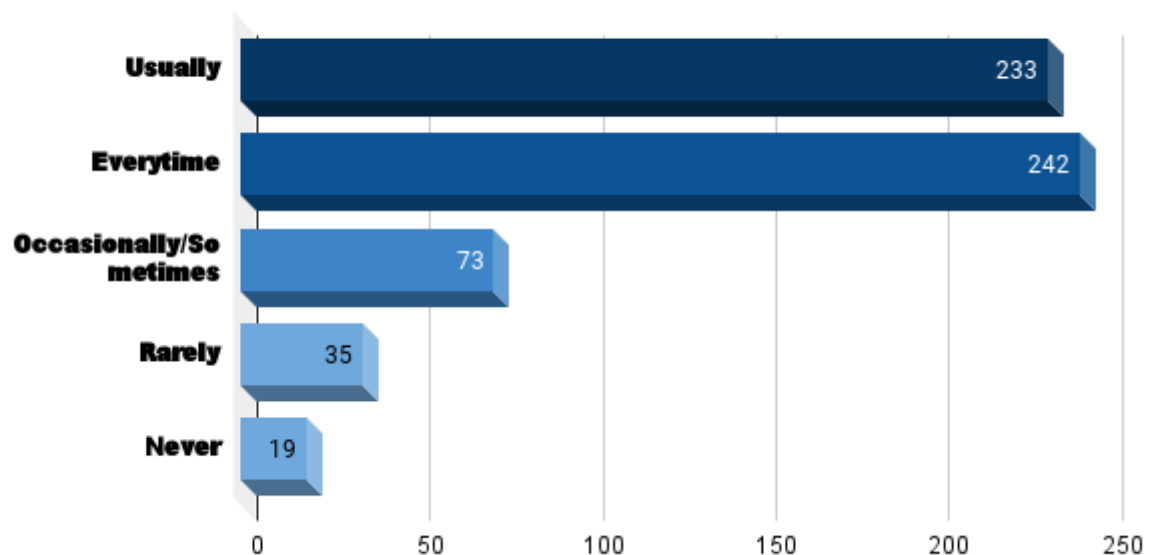
Out of 602 Students, 582 Students (96.67per cent) confirmed that teachers approach can be described as good and above.

5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by the teachers.



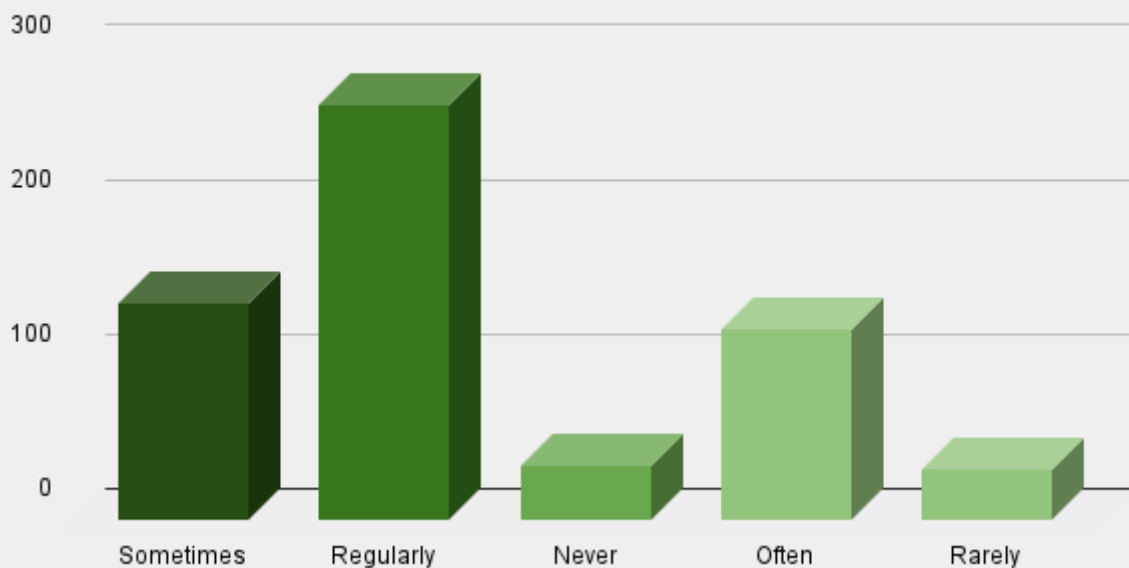
In all 78.57 per cent confirmed the fairness in internal evaluation process by the teachers.

6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you?



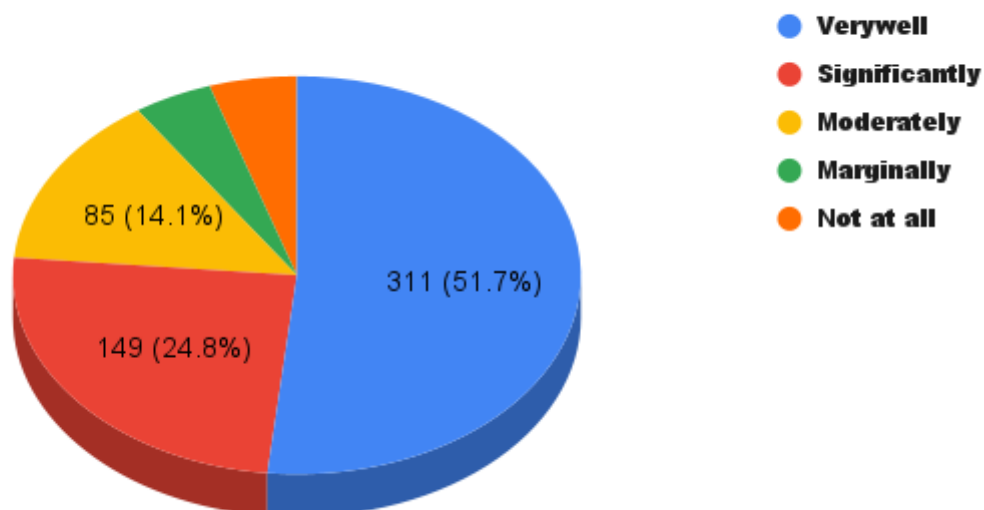
Out of 602 Students, 475 Students (78.90 per cent) confirmed that their performance in assignments discussed with them.

7. The institute takes active interest in promoting internship, student exchange, field visit opportunities for



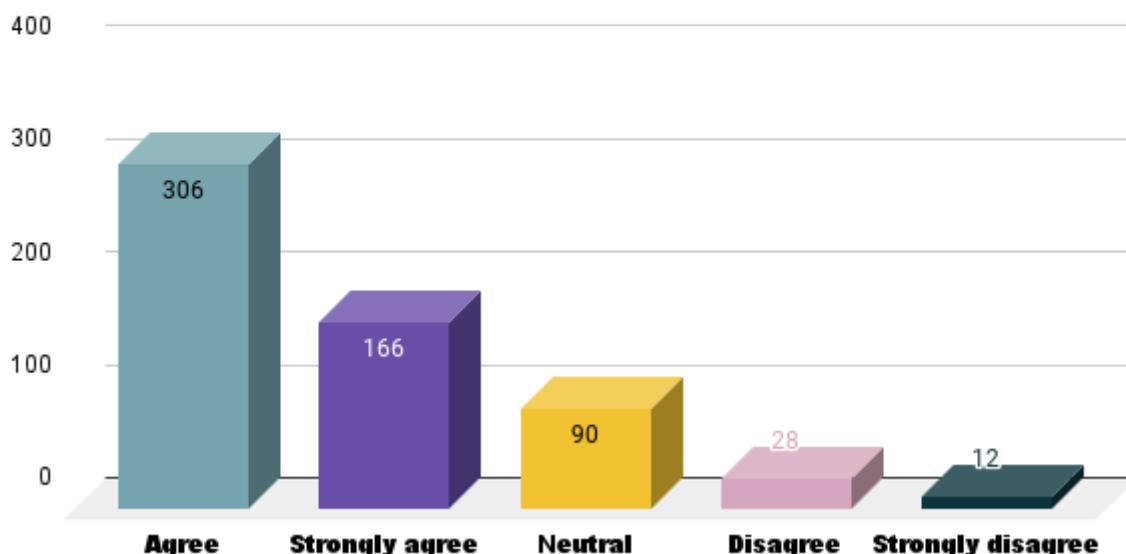
In all 68.11 per cent Students confirmed the fairness in internal evaluation process by the teacher.

8. The teaching and mentoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth.



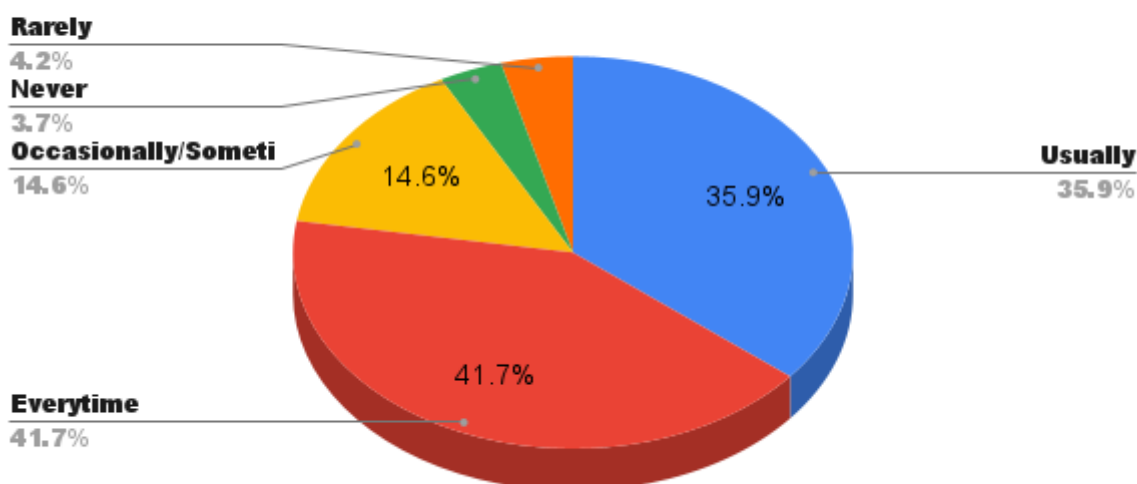
Out of 602 Students, 545 Students (90.53 per cent) confirmed that institute's teaching and mentoring process facilitates in cognitive, social and emotional growth.

9. The institution provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow



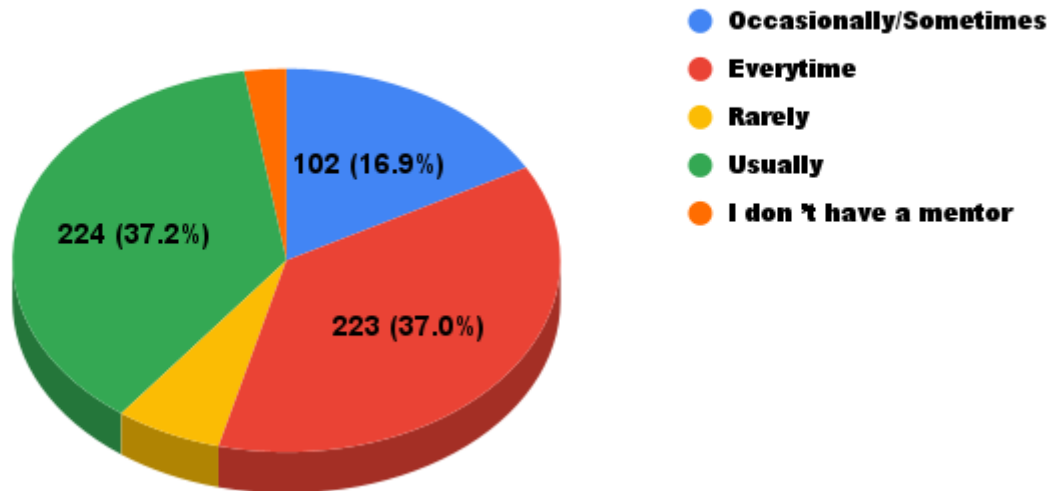
Out of 602 Students, 472 (78.41 per cent) Students confirmed that institute provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.

10. Teachers inform you about your expected competencies, course outcomes and programme



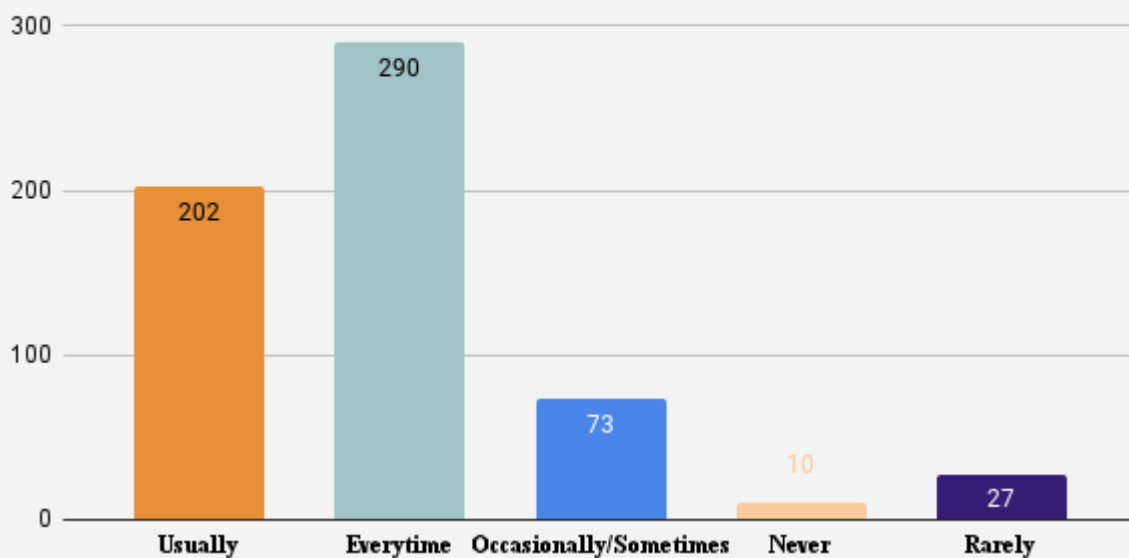

11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you.



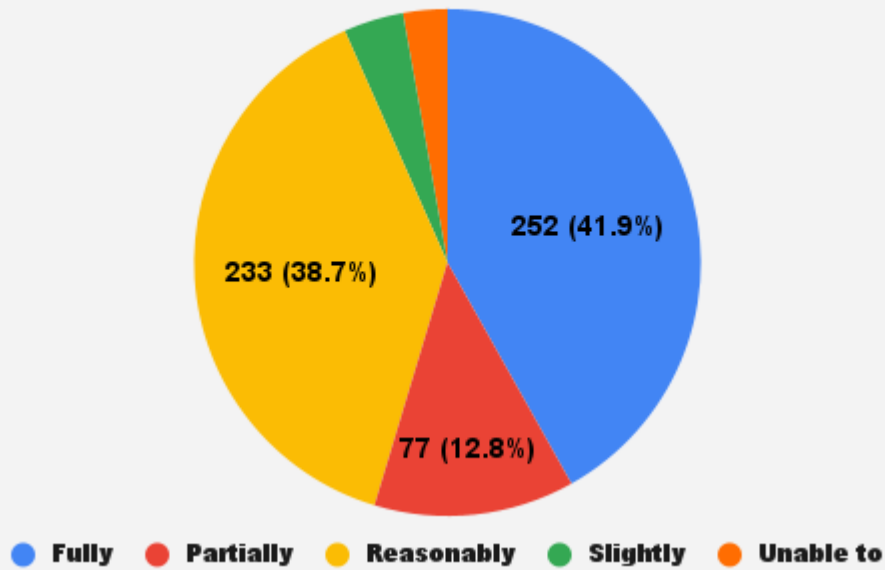
Out of 602 Students, 447 Students (74.25 per cent) confirmed that their mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to them.

12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.



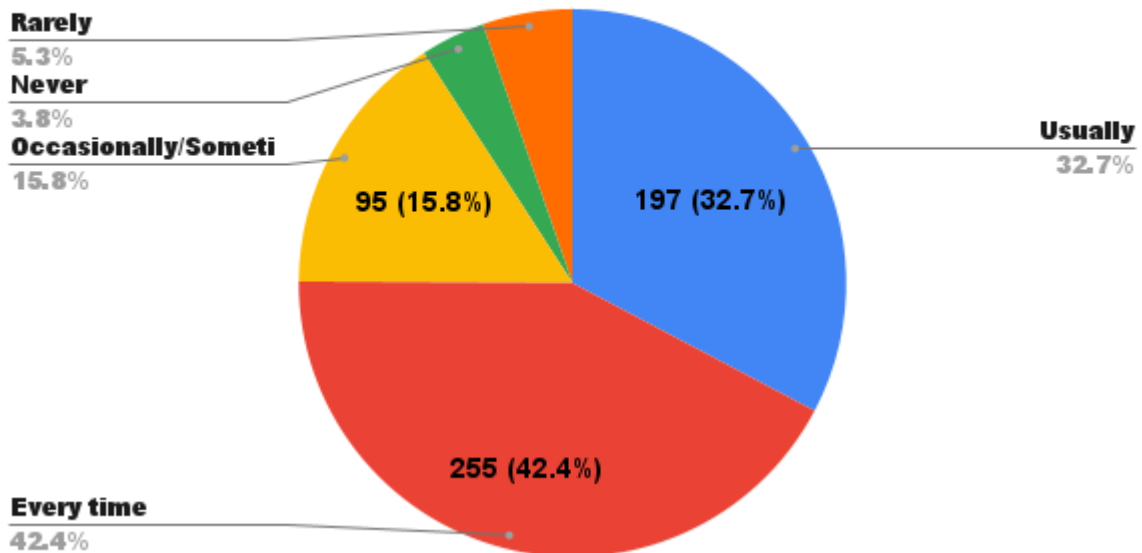
Out of 602 Students, 492 Students (81.73 per cent) confirmed that their teacher illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

13. The teachers identify your strengths and encourage you with providing right level of challenges.



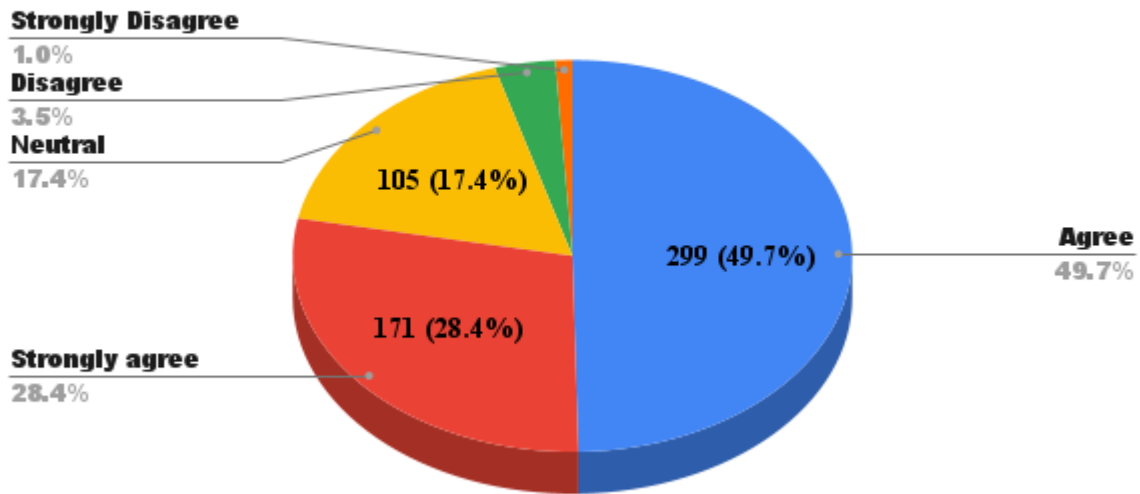
Out of 602 Students, 485 (80.56 per cent) Students confirmed that their teacher identify strengths and encourage us providing right level of challenges.

14. Teachers are able to identify your weaknesses and help you to overcome them.



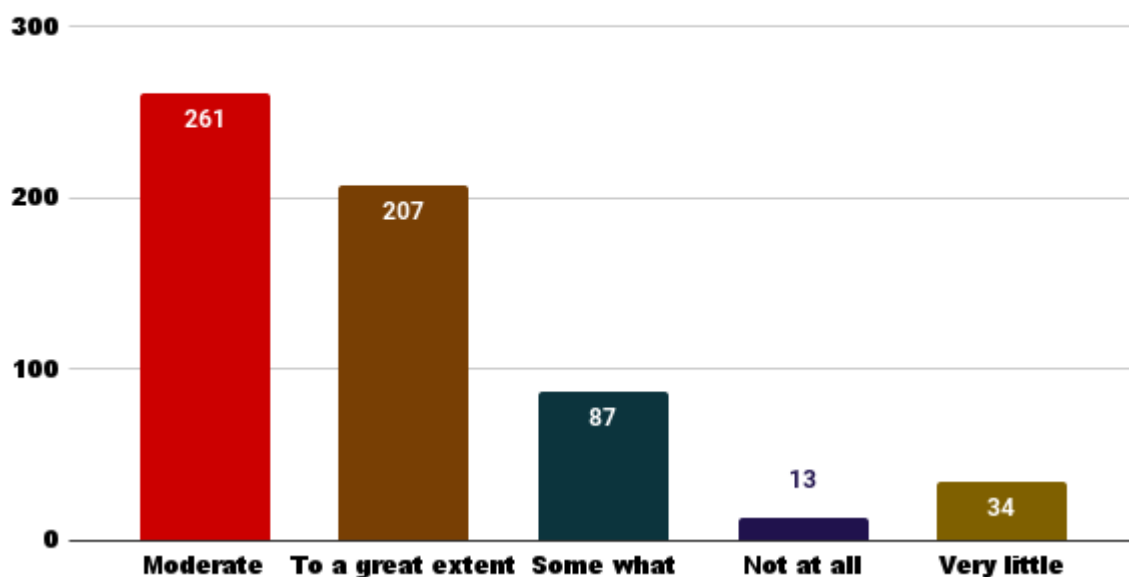
Out of 602 Students, 452 Students (75.83 per cent) confirmed that their teachers are able to identify their weaknesses and help to overcome them.

15. The institution makes effort to engage students in the monitoring, review and continuous quality



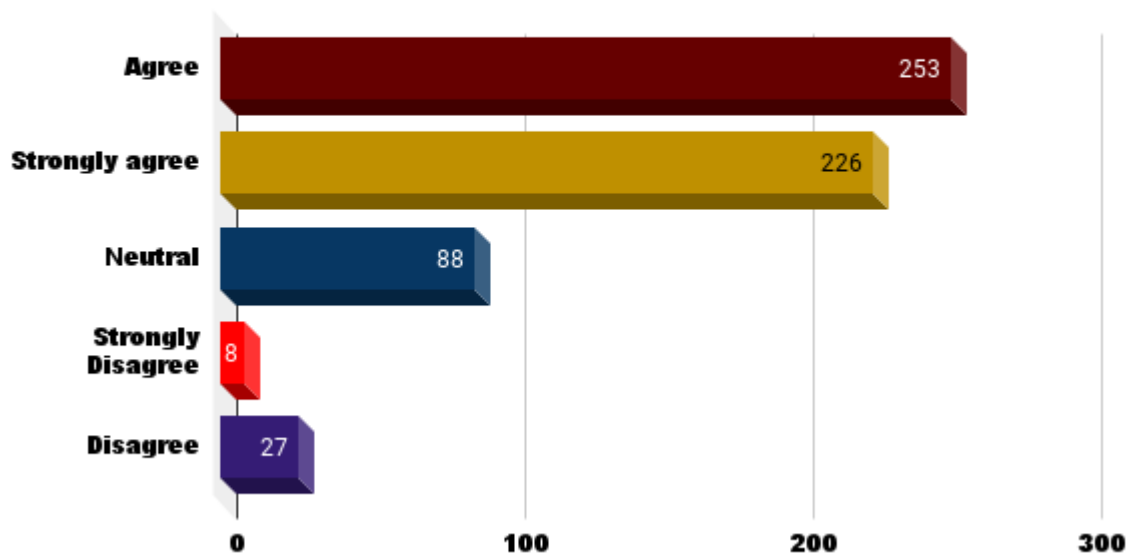

16. The institute/ teachers use student centric methods, such as experiential learning, participative learning and problem



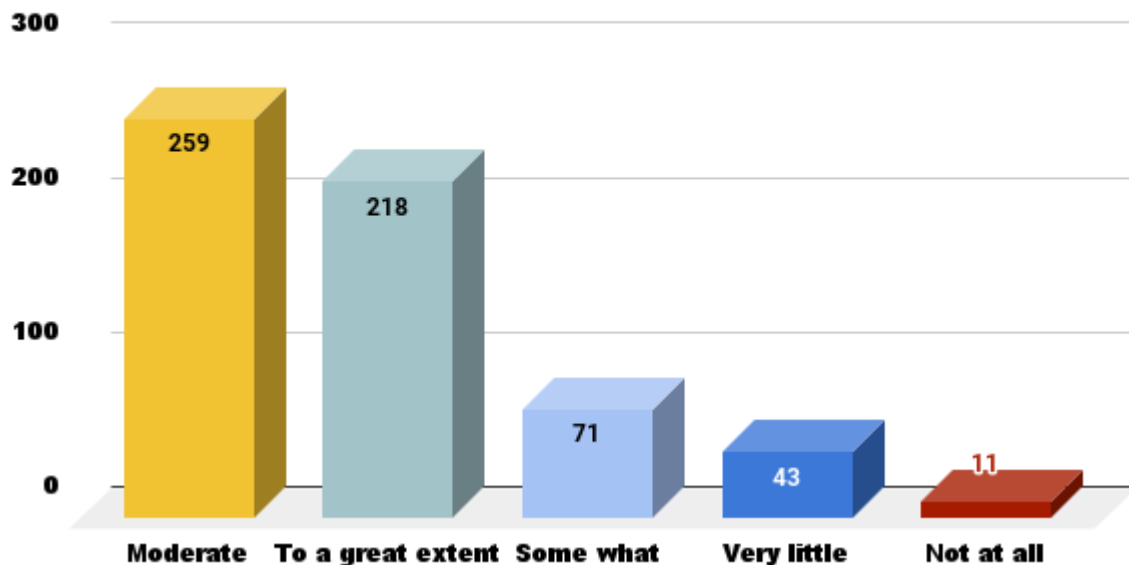

17. Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities.



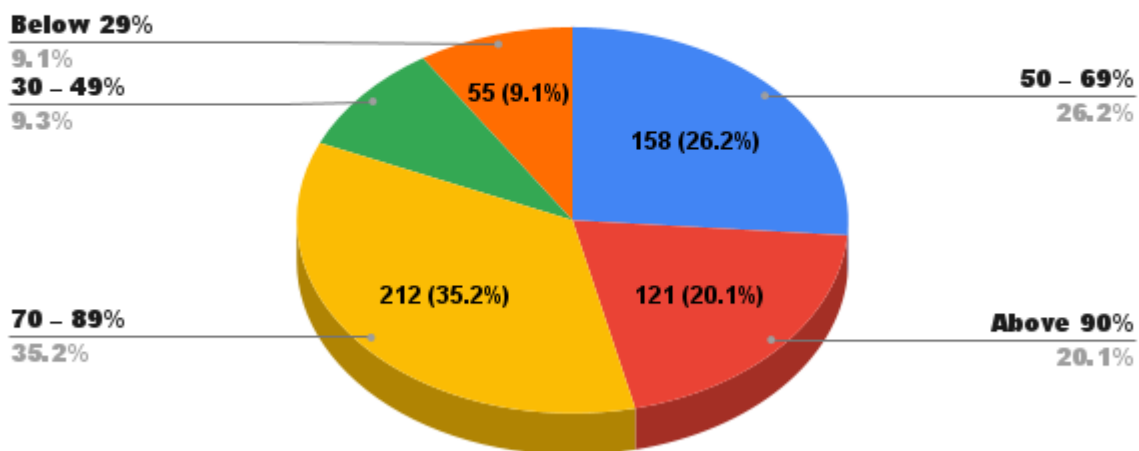
Out of 602 Students, 479 Students (79.57 per cent) confirmed that teacher's encourage us to participate in extracurricular activities.

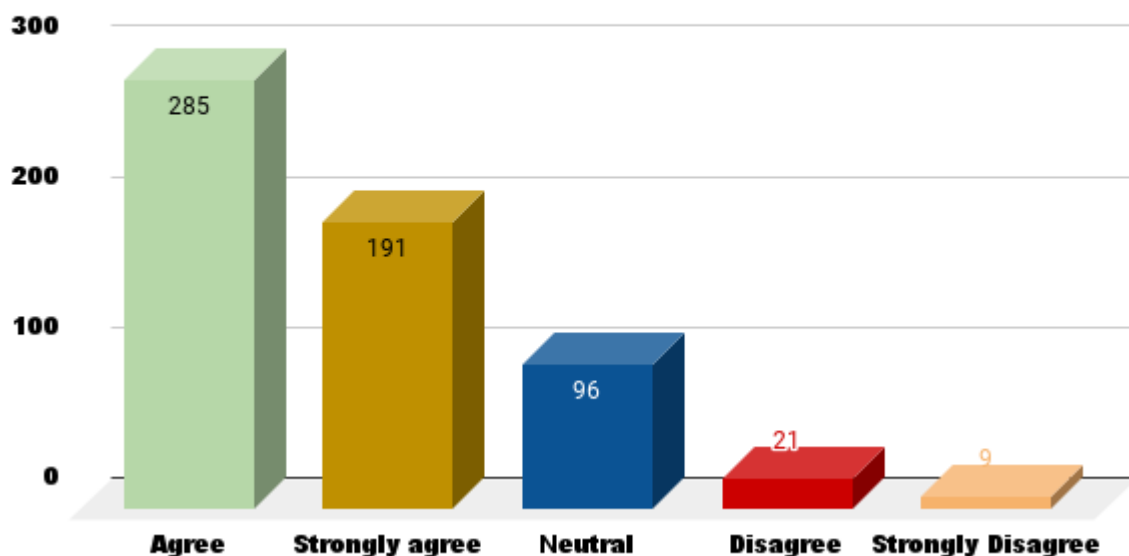

19. What percentage of teachers use ICT tools such as LCD projector, Multimedia, etc. while teaching.



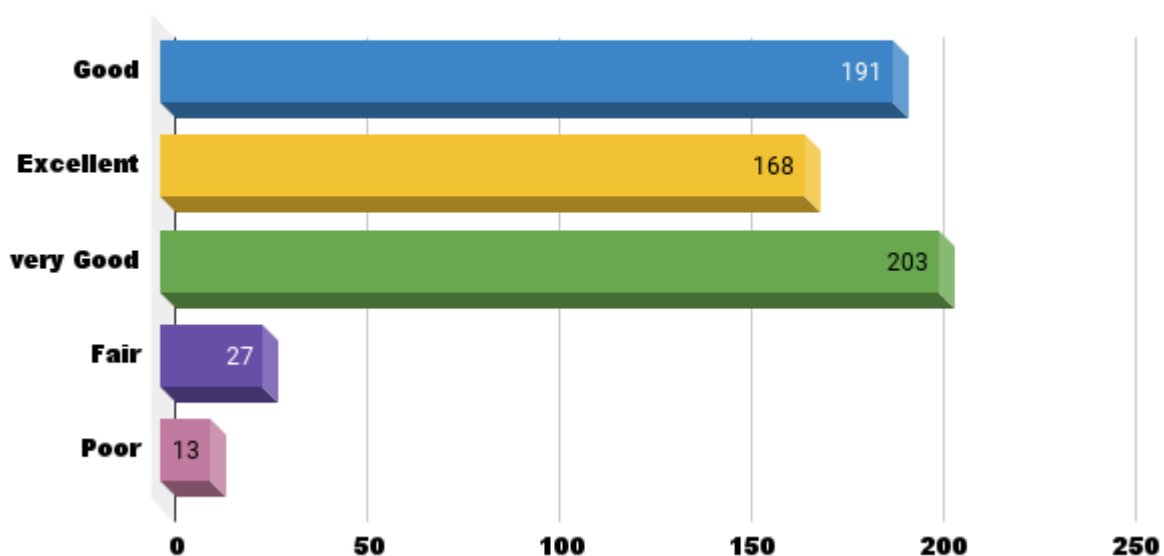

21. Quality of the programmes offered in our College?



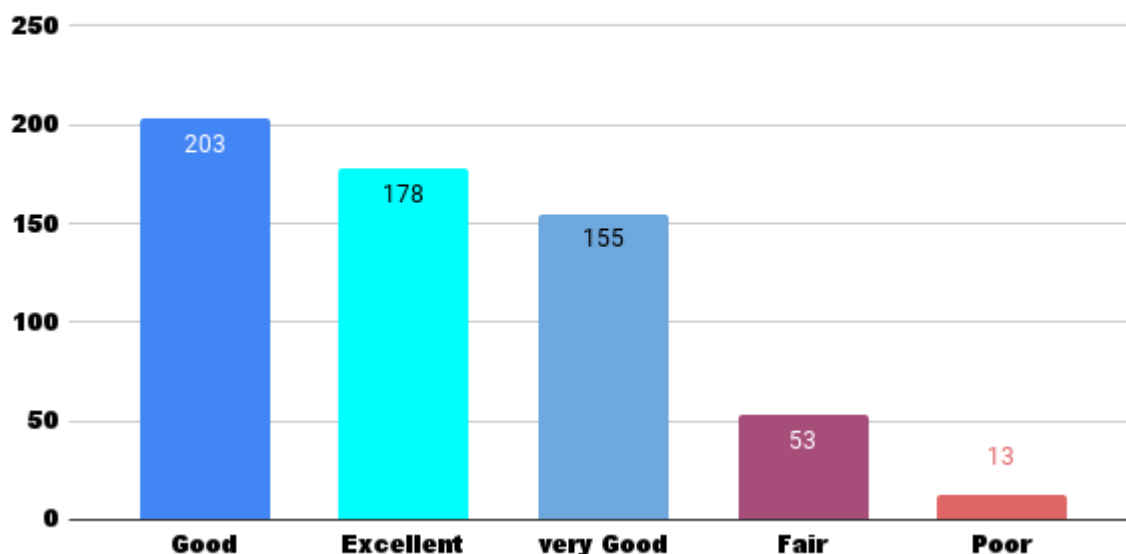
Out of 602 Students, 371 Students (61.63 per cent) confirmed that very good and above about quality of the programme offered by the institute.

22. Faculty Support for your continuous academic growth?



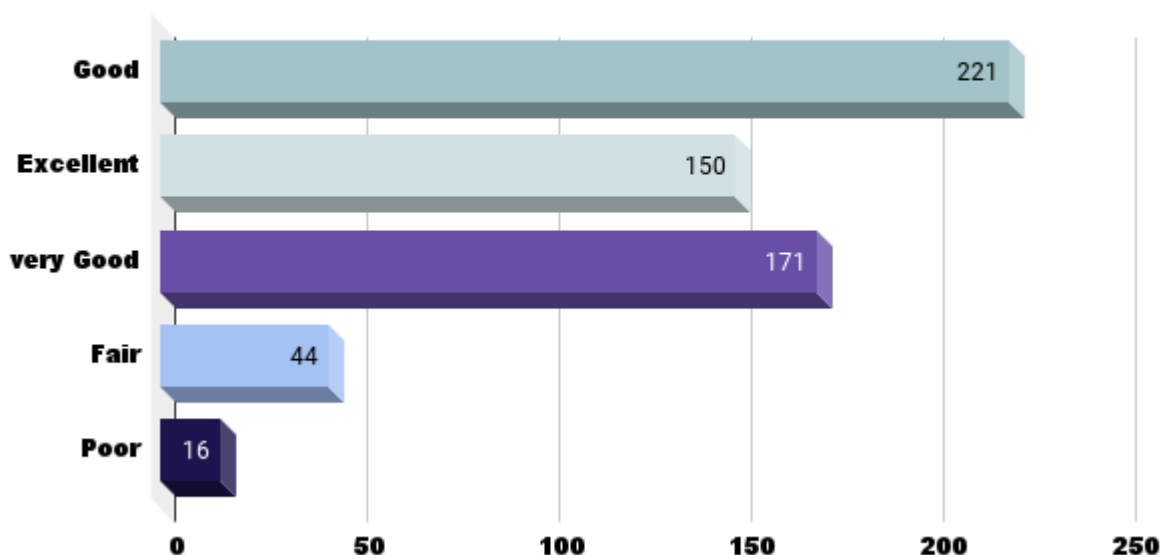
Out of 602 Students, 360 Students (59.80 per cent) confirmed that faculty support for continuous academic growth for students.

23. Library and laboratory facilities available in the campus promotes your academic pursuit



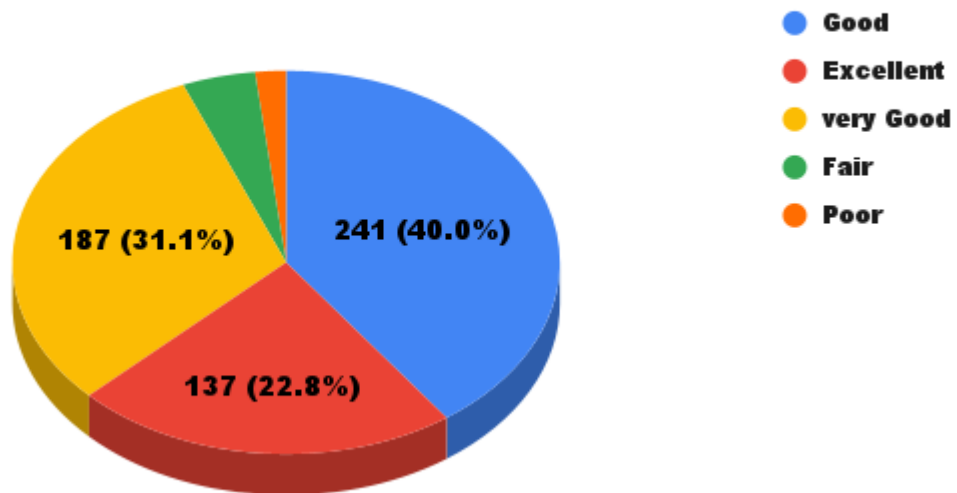
Out of 602 Students, 333 Students (55.32 per cent) confirmed that a Library and Laboratory facility available in the campus promotes academic pursuit for students.
